12. Driver Training

All our drivers are required to have a CDL license (over the age of 21 for Interstate) and have a license without any moving violations. ADS follows the guidelines set forth by the Department of Transportation regarding drug and alcohol testing, DOR driver qualification files and adheres to all safety guidelines set forth by our insurance company.

American Disposal Systems Inc. only hires truck drivers with a minimum of five (5) years commercial driving experience and who are experienced with the waste/recycling hauling vehicles such as roll-off trucks.

All drivers when hired are trained by the owner Chris Kasper in our operations and guidelines. Then all drivers in training ride along with our Lead CDL driver for 4-6 weeks. During that time, the driver is trained on how to use our waste hauling equipment, procedures and guidelines set forth by us and all the disposal facilities we use. Since we operate in three states currently, each state or county has their own rules and regulations regarding waste rules and regulations. Drivers are also trained to look for foreign materials in their loads that are not accepted per the disposal facility guidelines as well as materials that will contaminate recyclable materials. We tend not to send a driver to a disposal facility he has never been to before; therefore, we train the driver with a few drivers, so they learn all the various routes, disposal facilities and customer locations.

All drivers are provided with high vision work apparel, work boots, hard hats, emergency spill kits, accident tool kit, fire extinguisher and other miscellaneous safety tools. Also, all employees participate in monthly safety meetings on topics pertaining to commercial driving, safety and the waste disposal industry.
