Clean Delaware, LLC. has requested several amendments to their existing agricultural utilization (AGU) permit (State Permit Number AGU 1702-S-03). The current AGU permit authorizes the land treatment of stabilized biosolids generated at small volume wastewater treatment facilities and other approved land treatable wastes at agronomic rates onto three non-contiguous farms comprising a total of approximately 254 acres. The existing AGU permit also authorizes the application of lime-stabilized septage at agronomic rates onto a designated portion of the Milton Farm. The Milton Farm is located approximately one mile northwest of Milton, Delaware, the Harbeson site is located in the center of Harbeson, Delaware, and the Ellendale site is located approximately two miles east of Ellendale, Delaware.

The amendment request of Clean Delaware's existing AGU permit include a request to apply certain land treatable wastes directly onto a cover crop without incorporation into the soil, update field acreages based on a new survey, allow septage application onto additional fields, and adjust the frequency of sampling of land applied materials. Additionally, while the permit is being amended, additional safeguards will be added to the permit-ensure successful agricultural utilization program.

Parts III and V of the Department's Guidance and Regulations Governing the Land Treatment of Wastes allows for such activity pending public notice.

DNREC Secretary, Shawn M. Garvin announces 2020 Community Environmental Project Fund grants with CEFP program public workshops scheduled for Sept. 10 and 11

Department of Natural Resources and Environmental Control Secretary Shawn M. Garvin has announced the availability of Community Environmental Project Fund (CEPF) grants. The Community Environmental Project Fund was created by House Bill 192, in February 2004. HB 192 requires that CEPF funds benefit the communities where the civil or administrative violations occurred. It provides for the restoration of affected communities by funding environmental projects that result in:

- The reduction of pollution
- The enhancement of natural resources
- The enhancement of natural resources for the purposes of creating recreational opportunities for the citizens of Delaware.

IRS tax-exempt organizations are eligible for grants of up to \$20,000. These include: civic and community organizations, educational institutions, counties, municipal governments, state agencies and quasi-state agencies. The application deadline is Thursday, Oct. 31, 2019. The projects funded in this grant cycle will commence on July 1, 2020 and should be completed by June 30, 2021.
