Notice is hereby given that Dover Downs Gaming and Entertainment having a facility at 1131 North Dupont Hwy., Dover, Delaware, has requested a federally enforceable 7 DE Admin. Code 1102 construction permit (Permit: **APC-2020/0003-Construction (FEI)**) for the installation of two (2) 3.0 mmBtu condensing boilers. The boilers are permitted to emit 2.59 tpy of NOx, 0.02 tpy of SOx, 2.17 tpy of CO tpy of VOC, and 0.20 tpy of PM.

Upon completion of construction, the Department will incorporate the operating conditions and limits of the 7 DE Admin. Code Construction permit into the facility's existing Synthetic Minor (Permit: **APC-2001/0308-OPERATION (Amendment 8)(U (SM))**) via an Administrative Amendment.

The "draft/proposed" construction permit is being submitted for concurrent processing. If there are no significant comments "draft/proposed" construction permit will be issued as a final after the expiration of the EPA review period.

A request for a public hearing shall be in writing. The request must also show a familiarity with the application and a reasoned statement of the probable impact.
