This hearing is being held pursuant to 10 CFR Section 440.14, which requires a public hearing to be held on weatherization grant applications prior to submission to the U.S. Department of Energy, now referred to as DOE.

We have one grant application before us today for the Federal Fiscal Year 2020 for the Weatherization Assistance Program.

The application is available at the table outside the room and was posted to the DNREC Weatherization website, posted on the State Calendar, and was the subject of legal notices in a newspaper of statewide circulation published on Sunday, December 29, 2019, namely the News Journal and the Delaware State News.

This application is a continuation of the 2017 Weatherization Grant, representing the fourth year of a three-year term grant that has been extended by one year as per the guidance in the DOE Memorandum 055 dated November 4, 2019.

It is required by DOE that I inform you that President Trump signed into law the budget for federal departments and programs on December 16, 2019.

Next, the Department of Energy will determine the state allocations of the approved budget.

While the Department of Energy is determining the state allocation, states have been instructed to develop their State Plans using the same funding level as the DOE 2019 Appropriated Funds outlined in WPN 19-2A.

The Delaware Weatherization

Assistance Program will make the required adjustments to the State Plan when the allocations are announced. The WPN 19-2A used for the 2020 application allocation is \$717,370, as you will see in the grant application that is before us today.

In program year 2020, DNREC will be seeking a Subgrantee to provide weatherization services to Kent and Sussex Counties by using a state-approved procurement process.

1 The current Subgrantee providing 2 services in New Castle County, called the Energy Coordinating Agency, will continue to 3 4 provide services in that county. 5 DNREC is proposing to use the same rules and procedures currently in place in 6 7 the Weatherization Assistance Program to deliver weatherization services to clients 8 9 between now and March 31, 2021. 10 That concludes my prepared 11 testimony here today. I do, however, wish to 12 enter here three exhibits as follows: The News Journal Print Confirmation 13 14 of the Weatherization Assistance Program 15 Public Notice that was advertised on 16 December 29, 2019. 17 Number two: The Delaware State News Print Confirmation of the Weatherization 18 Assistance Program Public Notice that was 19 advertised on December 29, 2019. 20 21 And third, a copy of the 2020 22 Weatherization Assistance Program grant 23 application. I now will turn it back over to our 24
