RE: Draft Construction and Operation Permits

Dear Mr. Rebar,

Please find below comments from Mountaire regarding the draft Construction Permit #359191-05 and the draft Operations Permit #359191-06.

Draft Construction Permit #359191-05

- 1. Page 4 Future dryer and Class A solids should be removed.
- 2. Page 5 #2 DAF Cell 1B should be 2400 gpm, not 1800 gpm. DAF Cell 1B can operate either in parallel or independently. The DAFs will operate 24 hours/day 6 to 7 days a week.
- 3. Page 7 There is no mention of the UV system which is included in both the process flow diagram on page 4 and the Final Design Report.
- 4. Page 7 #11 There will be two (2) or three (3) screw presses installed for sludge dewatering depending on size and brand chosen.
- 5. Page 9 #3 There is only one (1) new lagoon and it will be synthetically lined.

Draft Operations Permit #359191-06

1. Page 6 – Future dryer Class A solids should be removed.
