 Notice of Public Hearing

The Department of Natural Resources and Environmental Control (DNREC), Division of Fish & Wildlife (DFW) will conduct a public hearing (Hearing Docket No.: 2020-R-F-0015) on the proposed revisions to the following regulations: 7 DE Admin. Code 3103 Striped Bass Recreational Fishing Season, Methods of Take, (Code 1304), Possession Limit and 7 DE Admin. Code 3104 Striped Bass Possession Size Limit, Exemptions.

The preliminary provisions of the Atlantic States Fisheries Commission's (ASMFCA) Addendum VI to Amendment 6 to the Atlantic Striped Bass Interstate Fishery Management Plan (ISMP) require a cooperative 12% reduction in striped bass removals (landings + discard mortality). The ASMFCA adopted specific prescribed cooperative management measures to meet the required 12% reduction, but those measures are not preferred for Delaware. Delaware developed two management options that were approved by the ASMFCA. If implemented by the Department, would be equivalent to the specific cooperative management measures in Addendum VI. The first option results in a 4.12% reduction in commercial removals and a 20.8% reduction in recreational removals. The second option results in an 12% reduction in commercial removals and an 18.12% reduction in recreational removals. Both options cover the recreational season and season (1 striped bass at 20" - 29" in Delaware River, Bay & their tributaries from Jul 1 - Aug 31), but the two options differ for the recreational fishery as follows:

	Option 1	Option 2
Min. Length	28"	28"
Max. Length (not to be exceeded or exceeded)	33"	33"
Possession Limit	1	1

Option 1 is currently in effect due to Emergency Order No. 2020-E-0002, but adoption of either option will remain compliant with the FMP, as required by the Atlantic Coastal Fisheries Cooperative Management Act (16 USC §5101), et seq.). The proposed amendment may be imposed at DNREC's office location (by appointment only) located at Richardson & Rehms Building, 89 Kings Highway, Dover, DE 19901 and online as of June 1, 2020 at http://www.dnrec.delaware.gov/officehours/online_comments_form.html
