The Delaware Department of Natural Resources and Environmental Control, Underground Storage Tank Branch has reviewed the Final Report for Closure on the above-referenced site. The report meets the Department's closure standards for LUST sites.

Based on the analytical data submitted, it appears that residual soil contamination has been reduced to non-detectable levels, and that no threat to human health or the environment is present. As a result, no further action is required at this time.

However, this letter does not absolve the responsible party from accountability for any future problems related to the underground storage tank(s) formerly at this location. If a related problem is identified, the Department must be notified and immediate action must be taken to eliminate any threat to public health and safety, and to the environment.
