WHEREAS, the State of Delaware is the owner of ungranted subaqueous lands lying beneath the waters of Herring Creek; and

WHEREAS, Matthew D. Eisenmann and Colleen K. Eisenmann, owner(s) of certain lands adjoining to Herring Creek have applied for permission to occupy 456 square feet of those public lands to install the indicated structures for private use; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of 7 Del. C. §7203, the Secretary of the Department of Natural Resources and Environmental Control through his duly authorized representative finds that it is not contrary to the public interest if this project is approved subject to the terms and conditions herein set forth.

This Lease shall be continued for a period of ten (10) years or so long as the conditions attached to the Lease are adhered to, whichever is the shorter in time. Upon the expiration of the ten-year term, this Lease shall expire and become null and void, unless prior thereto the lessee shall have applied for and received a renewal of this Lease. A renewal may be denied if the State determines that the Lease is no longer in the public interest.

NOW THEREFORE, this Lease is issued subject to the attached Subaqueous Lands Lease General Conditions and the following special conditions:

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

- 1. This Lease replaces all previously-issued subaqueous lands leases associated with this tax parcel (SL-144/07, SU-223/10, SL0144/07(T1)) which are hereby voided. Existing structures shall be removed prior to the construction of authorized structures granted by this lease, if not incorporated within the approved plans.
- 2. This Lease maintains the Agreement of Easement authorized within SU-223/10 for the portions of structure originally authorized by SL-144/07.
- 3. This Lease shall not be considered valid until it has been duly recorded in the office for the Recorder of Deeds in and for the appropriate County, and a copy of the recorded Lease is returned to, and has been received by, the Department.
- 4. This approval is in accordance with the plans and application submitted to the Department of Natural Resources and Environmental Control, a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof.
- 5. To protect diadromous fish species during their migration and spawning seasons, a time of year restriction from **March 1**st to **June 30**th is required.
- 6. The work authorized by this Lease is subject to the terms and conditions of the attached Department of the Army Permit Number CENAP-OP-R SPGP-20.
- 7. This Lease is granted for the purpose of berthing no more than four vessels, as indicated on the approved plans. Any other use without prior approval shall constitute reason for this Lease being revoked.
- 8. The authorized area of structure over public subaqueous lands is 456 square feet, represented by the 4 by 50 foot long portion of pier, 4 by 45 foot long pier extension, a 6 by 12 floating platform, and 4 pilings associated with a boatlift, channelward of mean low water.
