Good morning. We are homeowners in the townhomes at Lake Comegy's (#15). We live directly across the lake from where the proposed dock would be erected. For the last 8+ years, our family has enjoyed our precious pond/lake. The wildlife, turtles and fish are abundant and this pond/lake is most certainly what keeps us here. Our community of Lake Comegy's does our part to keep Lake Comegy's healthy and protected to ensure that it remains the treasure that it is. We are strongly opposed to any proposal to build a dock that is larger than the others. Any sized dock will almost certainly destroy the habitat in and around where it is erected. Lake Comegy's is not that big as it stands, but, at any given time, you will see dozens of turtles and countless fish from just about any vantage point. It is also not that deep. Our concern is what this does to the aquatic life when you take up precious space in their home for personal gain. Growing up in the most rural parts of Delaware for the better part of our lives, we recognize that these resources are becoming more and more scarce as homeowners and landowners develop and build.
