I attended the hearing and have read the various comments submitted concerning the proposed dock. My observation of those who are opposed to the construction of the dock and wetland walkway is that they have not offered anything more than mere speculation of a negative impact. Nothing presented opposing the dock was of substance nor offered any feasible or valid reason to block the construction or reduce the size of the dock. It appears the owners (Abby Pubusky and Thomas Taylor) went through the proper channel and worked with DNREC to submit a plan that was within established regulations. In addition, DNREC did its due diligence with onsite surveys and reviews to ensure compliance with said regulations.
