
Hearing for the Delaware Recyclable Products, Inc. (DRPI)'s Industrial Waste Landfill Permit Modification Application

- Issued by DNREC on December 30, 2015.
- Expires on December 30, 2025.
- Issued to the Delaware Recyclable Products, Inc. (DRPI, the Permittee).

 Issued pursuant to 7 Delaware Code, Chapter 60, (the Statute) which prohibits the disposal of solid waste without a permit.

Under the Statute, a permittee is subject to civil, administrative and criminal penalties for violating any condition of their permit.

The Statue establishes regulations that govern solid waste facilities (DRGSW).

 Permit SW-15/02 was issued pursuant to the Statue and based upon requirements specified by Delaware's Regulations Governing Solid Waste (DRGSW).

The permit also specifies other plans and procedures deemed necessary by DNREC.

 Permit Condition III.H.2 and III.N.2 specifies Department on-site compliance inspector's role.(Arron Wayson 302-853-0349)

## **The Process**

- Permit Modification Application Administratively Complete (4/1/2019)
- Public Notice of the Permit Modification Application (4/11/2019 to 4/26/2019)
- Hearing Request Received (4/11/2019)
- Public Notice of Public Hearing for the Permit Modification Application (4/28/2019)
- Public Hearing (5/29/2019)
- Hearing Officer's Report
- Secretary's Decision
- Permit Modification as requested/Permit Modifications with conditions/Permit Denial

## **Proposed Modifications**

- Increase final elevation from 130 feet to 190 feet.
- Add additional culverts connecting the perimeter swale to the stormwater ponds.
- Daily monitoring for leachate seeps per DRGSW (effective May 2018).
- Increase operational cover frequency from 2 weeks to weekly or when windy conditions are forecast.
