This letter is to notify you that a public hearing has been scheduled on the November 18, 2021, Natural Minor Permit Amendment Applications submitted by Highline Warren LLC (formerly Twinco Romax LLC) for the request to amend the existing permits to allow for an increase in the raw material throughput through the Process Filling Line and Above Ground Storage Tanks (ASTs) at the 1 Crowell Road, Wilmington, Delaware Facility.

The Virtual Public Hearing will be held on Tuesday, October 18, 2022, at 6pm. Please note that verbal and written comments will be accepted. The specific details on how to submit written comments or how to register to submit verbal comments will be detailed in the Public Hearing Legal Notice which is scheduled to be posted in the News Journal and Delaware State News on Sunday, August 21, 2022. Please note that the hearing will only cover issues related to the air permit applications. It will not cover concerns related to truck traffic.
