As a concerned resident of the Pleasant Hill Estates, I am writing requesting a public hearing regarding the Twinco/Highline request to expand, increasing their throughput of raw materials. After reviewing the public notice on the DNREC site, I understand that if approved by DNREC, the permitted emissions will actually decrease. Emissions decrease is certainly a positive thing for our community. However my concern, as is many others in our community, is that this approval, while positive for emissions, the expansion of Twinco/Highline will increase the tractor-trailer traffic on Mac Arthur Drive and Lindberg Avenue. This is already a huge problem, very hazardous and not at all appropriate for our neighborhoods. For years, many home owners have been quite concerned about the tractor-trailer traffic in our neighborhood and continue to raise this concern with our state representatives without resolution to date. While emissions and the inappropriate tractor-trailer traffic may be 2 different issues, approval for the Twinco/Highline request by DNREC will certainly increase the tractor-trailer traffic. This will surely result in more hazardous conditions for our community, already a huge problem for home owners and families. I am requesting of DNREC, that no approval be granted until an alternative route for the tractor-trailer traffic is established.
