I write to you, because I am opposed to the mandate regarding electric vehicles.

My husband and I have own a small business in Delaware since 2004. We have worked hard to build our business, we provide equipment rental and flagging services for road construction. We have 27 vehicles in our fleet, gas and diesel, that if we are mandated to replace the vehicles would put a huge burden on our business.

We provide Truck Mounted Attenuators for the job sites that require them to stay on the project for long periods of time, with their lights on, for the safety of the workers on the job site and the public. We also move equipment, pull equipment so what our job requires is a powerful vehicle for these processes.

Can these electric vehicles provide the same functionality as gas and diesel vehicles?

This seems like a burden that our business would not survive in my opinion.

I urge you to reconsider the electric vehicle mandate. Our State, our Country are trying to survive a recession right now and this mandate seems to add to our burdens, not help us.
