DNREC,

We are pushing this EV agenda before we have the infrastructure in place to meet the demand! Also, my wife and I are retired and on a fixed income. We will not be able to afford the cost of a new car nor the cost of adding the electric outlet plug to our home.

Furthermore, the high cost of maintenance and battery replacement we would not be able to afford. A battery replacement can cost anywhere from \$5,000 upwards to \$25,000.

The range of these EV is from 100 to 500 miles. EV's with the highest range can cost anywhere from \$100,000 to \$150,000.

Finally, EV charging can take from 30 min. to hours to charge, depending, on if the plug-in is Level 1, 2 or DC.

We are totally against the CA Vehicle Emissions Law for Delaware. DNREC and the Governor is forcing this upon citizens that don't want these controls.

Please take into consideration the increase and growing population base of retired citizens living in Delaware.
