Hello, I'd like to comment on the proposed rules to adopt the California standards that push us into full ZEV ownership in the next decade. I'm not opposed to electric vehicles, but I have real concerns about the availability and reliability of the charging network. Until Delaware presents a clear plan on how they will insure that recharging is as easy and reliable as gassing up, I will not be in support of this change. Security of the electrical grid is another serious concern given the increase in attacks on electrical infrastructure over the last few years in America.
