I currently work at a manufacturing plant where we hire low-income workers to fill jobs. Many of these are already struggling to keep older vehicles operational, so they can get to work. Many car pool because they can't afford a vehicle on their own. The idea that they would be able to afford (conservatively) a \$50,000 -\$60,000 electric vehicle is absurd. I can't afford such a vehicle, and I make substantially more than they do. Not only do the vehicles come with a horrific price tag, they're also more expensive to operate. And there's the added expense of having to rewire your garage. Then there is the fact that the batteries only last a handful of years, and it's usually cheaper to purchase a new vehicle then replace the batteries. We looked up what the batteries cost.
