I write to express my strong support for the regulations set forth in Advanced Clean Car 2, support already expressed verbally in two hearings. My architectural practice and my home are both in Wilmington. The regulations do not present an obstacle to those who wish, for whatever reasons, to continue to buy gas powered cars. It does enable those who wish to buy an electric powered vehicle to do so within Delaware.

The movement toward electrical vehicles is ineluctable as demonstrated by the magnitude of new investments in the construction of factories in our country for building these vehicles as well as for the batteries and the other devices supporting them.

As a state that could suffer enormously from the coastal rise exacerbating natural tectonic changes, Delaware has a special responsibility to take whatever measures it can to control climate change. The failure to facilitate the change away from fossil fuels will harm every citizen, but most egregiously those of low income. We cannot allow the Caesar Rodney Institute and other perpetrators of misinformation, distortions, and lies to shape public policy.
