The Department of Natural Resources and Environmental Control (DNREC), Division of Air Quality (DAQ) will conduct a virtual public hearing (Docket #2022-R-A-0011) on Wednesday, April 26, 2023, beginning at 6:00 p.m. to consider comments from the public on the proposed amendments to regulation: 7 DE Admin. Code 1140 "Delaware Low Emission Vehicle Program."

The purpose of the amendments to 7 DE Admin. Code 1140 is The purpose of the amendments to 7 DE Admin. Code 1140 is to update the adoption by reference of California's Advance Clean Car II (ACC II) low emission vehicle and greenhouse gas standards and add the requirements for zero emitting vehicles for model year 2027 and beyond. The ACC II regulations will reduce criteria and greenhouse gas emissions from new light- and medium-duty vehicles beyond the 2025 model year as well as add the new requirements for zero emission vehicles. These standards were adopted in 2010 and went into effect for model year 2014, and since the original adoption California has made changes necessary for automobile manufactures to comply. Section 177 of the Clean Air Act requires that Delaware standards must be "identical to the California standards." California standards."
