19	and Secretary Garvin has appointed me
20	to serve as the Hearing Officer for the
21	formal proceeding.
22	First and foremost, this
23	hearing is being conducted virtually.
24	Everyone is participating virtually at

3 1 their own respective locations. we are not physically gathered, Webex 2 does generate a list of those that are 3 virtually present for the proceedings 4 so that the Department will have a 5 record of those who have electronically 6 7 joined this event. 8 At the conclusion of the 9 introductory remarks, I will be turning 10 the hearing over to the Department 11 staff to provide their presentation for 12 the record being generated in this 13 matter. In order to ensure that 3 4 everyone who wishes to offer comment to 5 the Department is considered, the record in this matter shall remain open 6 through September 30th, 2022. 7 8 There is only one authentic 9 record of this formal proceeding, and 10 it is the official court reporter's 11 verbatim transcript. 12 Lastly, per DNREC standard 13 hearing protocols, there will be no Q and A or chat session permitted 14 15 during this hearing. As previously stated, DNREC 16 17 wishes to ensure that everyone is 18 enabled to offer their comment for inclusion into the record being 19 20 generated in this matter; therefore, 21 the record will remain open through September 30th, 2022 so that the public 22 23 may offer written comment, should they 24 wish to do so. 1	Newman. My name is Karen Forrest, and
2	I serve as a Planner II for the
3	Delaware Weatherization Assistance
4	Program.
5	This hearing is being held
6	pursuant to 10 CFR Section 440-16(a),
7	which requires a public hearing be held
8	on weatherization grant applications
9	prior to submission to the U.S.
10	Department of Energy. We have one
11	grant application before us today for
12	the Federal Fiscal Year 2023 beginning
13	on October 1st, 2022 for the
14	Weatherization Assistance Program.
15	The grant application is
16	available online at the DNREC
17	Weatherization Assistance Program page
18	at de.gov/wap. It was posted on the
19	State Calendar and was the subject of
20	legal notices in newspapers of
21	statewide circulation published on
22	Friday, February 26, 2022, namely the
23	News Journal and the Delaware State
24	News.

1	This application is a new	
2	Weatherization Grant representing the	
3	Bipartisan Infrastructure Law (BIL)	
4	first year in a five-year grant cycle.	
5	It is required by the Department of	
6	Energy that I inform you of the BIL	
7	budget. The Weatherization Program	
8	Notice (WPN BIL) 22-1 and 22-2 used for	
9	the 2022 application allocation is	
10	\$10,189,866, as you will see in the	
11	grant application before us today.	
12	From that, the DOE requires \$1,817,076	
13	be spent on training and technical	
14	assistance. The Weatherization	
15	Assistance Program will make the	
16	required revisions to the State Plan,	
17	if necessary	
18	In program year 2023, there	
19	will be a subgrantee to provide	
20	services to support the Weatherization	
21	Grant representing the BIL. The first	
22	program year is considered a ramp up	
23	period by the DOE, and, therefore, much	
24	of the required training will be

1	completed this year.
