Page 4 1 PROCEEDINGS 2 HEARING OFFICER: Good evening. Thank 3 you for taking the time to join us tonight. The time is now 6:00 p.m. on Tuesday, November 28, 2023. 4 For ADA compliance, tonight's formal 5 6 proceeding offers closed captioning in a variation of 7 languages. Before I begin my introductory remarks, I 8 will hand it over to Tanesha Perry to go over the 9 closed captioning features, which will enable you to 10 view multiple languages on the Zoom platform. 11 Tanesha, you may begin. 12 MS. PERRY: Hello. My name is Tanesha 13 Perry. I am the administrative specialist with Office 14 of the Secretary. I'm here to assist the hearing 15 officer tonight. I'd like to make sure that everyone 16 is aware that the Zoom platform we're using has the 17 ability for closed captioning in multiple languages. 18 To start closed captioning, if you're 19 using a computer, at the bottom of your screen, you 20 should see "show captions" button. If you do not see 21 the "show captions" button, you may have to select the 2.2 three dots that say "more." 23 Once you find the "show captions" 24 button, you should click the carrot pointing up which

1 will bring up your translation options. You can 2 select your preferred language from there. 3 If your preferred language isn't listed, you can select "more" and all of the languages 4 will be listed. 5 6 If you're on a smartphone, at the 7 bottom of your screen, select the "captions" button 8 indicated by CC. If your preferred language is not 9 listed at the bottom, you may have to select the three 10 dots that say "more." You should then select "meeting 11 settings" with the gear icon next to it. Once the 12 13 settings page comes up, located at the very bottom, 14 select "translation language." From there, you'll be 15 able to select your preferred language, then select 16 "done" at the top right corner, and then "done" again. 17 If the captions are not automatically 18 popped up yet, you may need to select "captions" again 19 and select "show captions." 20 Now I'll turn it back over to the 21 hearing officer, Theresa Smith. 2.2 HEARING OFFICER: Thank you, Ms. Perry. Again, my name is Theresa Smith, as Ms. 23 24 Perry just said, and Secretary Garvin has appointed me

to serve as the hearing officer for tonight's formal
proceeding.

3 We are here this evening to provide a virtual platform for the State of Delaware's 4 Department of Natural Resources & Environmental 5 6 Control to conduct a virtual public hearing on Docket Number 2023-R-A-0016, the proposed revisions to 7 8 "Moderate Non-Attainment Plan for New Castle County, 9 for the 2015 8-Hour Ozone National Ambient Air Quality 10 Standard - State Implementation Plan."

The purpose of the hearing is to build a record in regard to the hearing by providing a formal legal platform for the public to learn about the proposed revisions and to enable the public to offer live comment.

16 Immediately following the adjournment 17 of the hearing, we will conduct the same hearing 18 platform for the proposed revisions to Delaware's 19 performance standard certification for the Moderate 20 Non-Attainment Plan for New Castle County, for the 21 2015 8-Hour Ozone National Ambient Air Quality Standard, Docket Number 2023-R-A-0017. Much of which 2.2 23 will be said now will be said again, so please bear 24 with me as you will hear the same introductory remarks 1 twice this evening.

2	First and foremost, this hearing is			
3	being conducted virtually. No one is together int eh			
4	same room. Everyone is participating independently at			
5	their own respective locations.			
6	While we are not physically gathered			
7	tonight, however Zoom does generate a list of those			
8	who are virtually present for the proceeding, so the			
9	Department will have a record of those who have			
10	electronically joined this event.			
11	There is a court reporter virtually			
12	present who will prepare a verbatim transcript of this			
13	hearing pursuant to the statutory requirement for			
14	DNREC to have the same prepared. And as always, that			
15	transcript will be posted on the hearing webpage			
16	dedicated to this matter as soon as it is received.			
17	In addition, I would encourage those			
18	who are attending the hearing to also visit the			
19	hearing webpage dedicated to this matter for			
20	additional details concerning the proposed			
21	The hearing webpage can be found online			
22	under the administrative law section of DNREC's			
23	website that will be listed at the conclusion of			
24	tonight's hearing.			

1 At the conclusion of my introductory 2 remarks, I will be turning the hearing over to the 3 Department's staff to provide their presentation for the record being generated in this matter. 4 5 Whereas the Department would have then 6 opened up verbal comment portion of the hearing 7 following the Department's presentation. The 8 Department did not receive registration for verbal 9 comment tonight. 10 It is important to note that the 11 Department offered the opportunity to register to give verbal comment as noticed in the legal ads and online. 12 13 Those who wished to have provided a verbal comment 14 would have had to register by 12:00 p.m. today, to 15 which there were no registrants by that time. 16 I would encourage those attending this 17 evening to go to DNREC's hearing webpage, under the 18 "administrative law" section where you can find more 19 details concerning the hearing matter, the hearing 20 record presented tonight, along with related documents 21 that are posted on the Department's hearing webpage 2.2 dedicated to this matter. 23 Before we begin the presentations, 24 please be advised that the following protocols remain

1 in place for all DNREC public hearings:

All comment received must be limited solely to the subject matter of tonight's hearing. All comments pertinent to the subject matter of the virtual hearing will be incorporated into the record being generated in this matter.

7 In light of the Administrative 8 Procedure Act, and to ensure that everyone who wishes 9 to offer comment for the secretary's consideration is 10 accommodated, the Department is required to, at a 11 minimum, provide a comment period of 15 days after the 12 hearing.

13There's only one authentic record of14this formal proceeding tonight, and it is the official15court reporter's verbatim transcript.

16 The statutory purpose of tonight's 17 hearing is to build a record with regard to the 18 Department's proposed actions. A record consisting of 19 a transcript of the hearing tonight, all written comments, all exhibits, and eventually the hearing 20 21 officer's report will be reviewed by Secretary Garvin. 2.2 The secretary will ultimately issue an 23 order following the review process containing his 24 decision on this matter, and the reasons therefor.

1 Per DNREC's standard hearing protocols, 2 there will be no Q&A or chat session permitted during 3 the hearing. 4 It is important to note that no 5 decision has already been made by the Department, nor 6 will a decision be made tonight with regard to the 7 proposed set matter. 8 As previously stated, DNREC wishes to 9 ensure that everyone is enabled to offer their 10 comments for inclusion into the record being generated 11 in the matter. As noticed in legal ads and online, 12 the Department stated that the public comment will be 13 open through December 13, 2023. 14 Comments may be submitted through a 15 comment form link on the hearing webpage, via email to 16 dnrechearingcomments@delaware.gov, or via the U.S. 17 Postal Service at the physical address for DNREC 18 indicated on the hearing webpage and on the notices 19 previously issued for this matter. 20 Written comments to DNREC may not be 21 submitted using social media platforms such as Twitter, Facebook, YouTube, or text messaging. 2.2 23 Please remember, all comments received 24 either through USPS or via the electronic mechanisms

noted just now, as long as received by the Department on or before December 13th, will bear the exact same weight and be considered equally by the secretary prior to making his final decision.

5 While all comments are appreciated, 6 each comment must be limited solely to the subject 7 matter of tonight's hearing. Multiple comments saying 8 the same thing do not outweigh one singular comment. 9 Simply put, comments are not votes. A single well-10 supported comment may carry more weight than a 11 thousand form letters.

I also want to note that only comments submitted directly to DNREC and entered by myself into the formal hearing record in this matter will be posted on the hearing webpage and be considered by the Department as a part of the hearing matter decision process.

The Department has not partnered with any outside organization or websites to assist with the public submission of comments in this matter, so again, only submit comments to DNREC directly. Lastly, the ultimate decision regarding this matter is made by DNREC's Secretary Garvin. This

24 formal proceeding tonight acts as a mechanism to

1	enable the Department to thoroughly vet the hearing
2	matter to the public and to let the public know
3	various ways which comment may be submitted for
4	Secretary Garvin's consideration, if so desired.
5	I will now hand it over to Carolyn Cook
6	with the Division of Air to provide the Department's
7	presentation.
8	MS. COOK: Good evening. My name is
9	Carolyn Cook and I'm an environmental scientist with
10	the Airshed Planning & Inventory Group for the
11	Division of Air Quality in the Delaware Department of
12	Natural Resources & Environmental Control.
13	The purpose of this hearing is to take
14	public comments on Delaware's proposed revisions to
15	the Moderate Non-Attainment Plan for New Castle County
16	for the 2015 8-Hour Ozone National Ambient Air Quality
17	Standard.
18	Delaware's state implementation plan
19	identifies how Delaware will attain and maintain air
20	quality. As defined in Title 40 of the Code of
21	Federal Regulations at part 52, subpart I.
22	The Environmental Protection Agency
23	promulgated a revised National Ambient Air Quality
24	Standard for Ground Level Ozone in 2015 of 70 parts

per billion. New Castle County was designated as non attainment for this new standard. Kent and Sussex
Counties were designated as attainment for this new
standard.

5 Ground level ozone, one of the 6 principle components of smog, is a serious air 7 pollutant that harms human health and the environment. 8 High levels of ozone can damage their respiratory 9 system and cause breathing problems, throat 10 irritation, coughing, chest pains, and greater 11 susceptibility to respiratory infection.

12 On June 4, 2018, the Environmental 13 Protection Agency designated 51 areas of the country 14 as non-attainment under the 2015 8-Hour Ozone National 15 Ambient Air Quality Standard.

Among those non-attainment areas is the Philadelphia, Wilmington, Atlantic City non-attainment area consistent of Pennsylvania, New Jersey, Maryland, and Delaware. Also known as the Philadelphia nonattainment area, including New Castle County in Delaware.

In the Environmental Protection Agency's designation process, the Philadelphia nonattainment area was designated as marginal. The

1	attainment deadline for marginal non-attainment areas			
2	was August 3, 2021. Failing to attain by the			
3	applicable attainment date requires that non-			
4	attainment areas be reclassified to moderate non-			
5	attainment for the 2015 Ozone National Ambient Air			
6	Quality Standard.			
7	On October 7, 2022, the Environmental			
8	Protection Agency redesignated the Philadelphia non-			
9	attainment area as moderate non-attainment for the			
10	2015 Ozone National Ambient Air Quality Standard based			
11	upon the failure of the non-attainment area to record			
12	data below the 70 parts per billion standard.			
13	Areas reclassified to moderate face			
14	more stringent Clean Air Act requirements designated			
15	to achieve attainment of the National Ambient Air			
16	Quality Standard by no later than August 3, 2024.			
17	Accordingly, the state air agencies in			
18	the Philadelphia non-attainment area were required to			
19	submit state implementation plan revisions called			
20	"non-attainment plans," and implement requirements to			
21	satisfy the statutory and regulatory requirements for			
22	moderate areas for the 2015 Ozone National Ambient Air			
23	Quality Standard.			
24	This proposed revision to Delaware's			

state implementation plan includes Delaware's non attainment plan for the 2015 8-Hour Ozone National
Ambient Air Quality Standard.

Having been designated as moderate, 4 Delaware must include the following elements in the 5 6 state implementation plan: Attainment modeling 7 demonstrates that the New Castle County portion of the 8 Philadelphia, Wilmington, Atlantic City, Pennsylvania, 9 New Jersey, Maryland, Delaware moderate non-attainment 10 area will attain the 2015 8-Hour Ozone National 11 Ambient Air Quality Standard in 2023.

12 Reasonable further progress ensures 13 that the air quality in New Castle County makes steady 14 and incremental progress toward attaining the 2015 15 8-Hour Ozone National Ambient Air Quality Standard. Control measures in emission reductions 16 17 detail existing controls needed to attain the 2015 8-Hour Ozone National Ambient Air Quality Standard. 18 19 Local vehicle emission budgets are 20 Delaware's 2023 mobile source budgets for portions of 21 total allowable emissions that are allocated to 2.2 on-road mobile sources for transportation conformity determination. 23 24 Contingency measures are specific

1 control measures to be implemented if the area fails 2 to make reasonable further progress, fails to meet any 3 applicable milestone, or fails to attain the National Ambient Air Quality Standard by the applicable 4 attainment date. 5 6 A base-year inventory establishes a 7 baseline emissions inventory. For this non-attainment 8 plan, the base year was 2017. Reasonably available 9 control technology is the lowest emission limitation 10 that a particular source is capable of needing by the 11 application of control technology that is reasonably available. 12 13 Reasonably available control measures 14 are measures necessary to achieve attainment as soon 15 as possible. 16 Delaware's gasoline vapor recovery 17 program includes systems for qasoline vapor recovery 18 of emissions from the fueling of motor vehicles. Α 19 non-attainment new source review certification 20 certifies the adequacy of Delaware's non-attainment 21 new source review program. 2.2 Delaware's motor vehicle inspection and maintenance program identifies problems with vehicle 23 24 emission control systems and ensures their repairs.

1	The general emission offset requirement offsets the
2	annual emissions increase from new sources or source
3	modifications to provide a new air quality benefit.
4	The ratio shall be at least 1.15 to 1 for moderate
5	non-attainment areas.
6	In today's hearing, the Department is
7	proposing additional non-substantive amendments to the
8	non-attainment plan in response to the Environmental
9	Protection Agency's pre-hearing review, including
10	typos and grammatical errors, removal of most
11	references and background regarding Sussex and Kent
12	Counties as they are not part of the Philadelphia non-
13	attainment area, and miscellaneous clarifications.
14	The Department now enters the following
15	exhibits into the public record to support the
16	approval of the state implementation planned
17	revisions.
18	Exhibit 1, Environmental Protection
19	Agency's final rule, 2015 Ozone National Ambient Air
20	Quality Standard reclassification of areas classified
21	as marginal.
