- 2.1.6 Add period to front of caliber numbers: .45 to .60
- 2.4.1 Incorrect word stricken. Strike "have", not "offset": with the exception being that coil-spring traps with a jaw spread of 4 inches or less and long-spring traps with a jaw spread of 4 ½ inches or less do not need to be have padded, laminated or have offset jaws, but must have a minimum jaw thickness of 1/8" as measured perpendicular across the face of the jaw where the two jaws meet when closed.
- 4.7.1 Incorrect word stricken. Strike "first", add "second":

...from September 15 (September 14, if September 15 is a Sunday) through the first second Saturday in February.

4.16 Changes not included. Add underlined "or trap":

Season. It shall be unlawful for any person to hunt or trap for diamondback terrapin during any period of the year, except between and including September 1 and November 15.

4.17.1 and 4.17.2 – confirm that the degree symbol is shown as a superscript after the temperatures and not a 0 as indicated now.

7.2.1 – "Anterless" is misspelled:

An approved tag <u>on a Deer Harvest Report Card</u> shall mean an <u>Anterless Antlerless</u> Deer Tag or Doe Tag received with the hunting license, Card <u>Deer Harvest Report Cards shall remain in a hunter's possession at all times while hunting deer.</u>

- 7.5.2 Change not included. Strike gun which is the last word in this subsection and replace with firearm:
 - ... when it also lawful to hunt deer with a gun firearm.
- 8.1.1 "established" should not be underlined as this text already exists in 3900:
 - 8.1.1 General. It shall be unlawful for any person to drive or operate a motorized vehicle upon any lands administered by the Division, except on established and maintained roads or as otherwise authorized by the Director.
- 8.3.5 Do not strike "to" as this word already appears in 3900 and we need to keep it:

8.3.5 Dikes. It shall be unlawful for any person to be in possession of any firearm on hunt from any dike administered by the Division, unless such person is temporarily crossing a dike at a ninety degree angle or traversing a dike to reach a Division authorized deer stand location during a deer firearms hunting season.

8.3.5 – Missing 8.3.5.1 in submitted regs. Would it be best to add to the end of current 8.3.5 so the new 8.3.5 would read as follows including the requested change immediately above:

8.3.5 Dikes. It shall be unlawful for any person to be in possession of any firearm on hunt from any dike administered by the Division, unless such person is temporarily crossing a dike at a ninety degree angle or traversing a dike to reach a Division authorized deer stand location during a deer firearms hunting season. It shall be unlawful for any person to crab or fish on or from any dike or water control structure or within any impoundment administered by the Division.

8.3.6 – Changes not indicated. "Resident" not stricken:

8.3.6 Deer Hunting By Driving. It shall be unlawful for residents to participate in deer drives, except where authorized on current wildlife area maps between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. No more than six (6) 6 resident hunters may participate in driving deer at any one time. Nonresidents may not participate in deer drives at any time. Nonresidents are restricted to hunting deer from stationary locations. Nonresidents may not possess a loaded firearm during the deer season, except to hunt from a stationary location or to retrieve a deer that they wound.

9.1.2.8 – inches should not be underlined as the word is already included in 3900:

9.1.2.8 Possessing, tending Tending or setting killer body-gripping traps with a jaw spread in excess of 5 inches.

14.4.2 proposed text changes not updated:

14.4.2 Falconry shall be a legal method of take for all game birds and game animals in Delaware. The hunting season for resident game, which excludes migratory game birds, shall be from September 1 through February 28 March 31.
