7 DE Admin. Code 3505 Striped Bass Commercial Fishing Seasons; Quotas; Tagging and Reporting Requirements

Current Gill Net Season

- The Spring Striped Bass Gill Net Season opens February 15 and closes May 31.
- The entire period is open for drift gill netting, but anchor gill netting is only open from March 1 through May 10.
- Anchor gill netting accounts for approximately 90% of spring striped bass gill net landings.
- Anchor netting is more efficient than drift netting but also can be more destructive:
 - Striped Bass discard mortality from anchor nets was 41% vs. 8% for drift nets in Delaware Bay studies.
 - Anchor nets kill other species, including ESA-listed Atlantic Sturgeon and waterbirds.

7 DE Admin. Code 3505 Striped Bass Commercial Fishing Seasons; Quotas; Tagging and Reporting Requirements Advisory Council on Tidal Finfisheries Recommends Season Change

- The Advisory Council on Tidal Finfisheries (Council) discussed modifications to the spring anchor gill net season with DNREC Division of Fish and Wildlife at its April 18 and September 19, 2023 meetings.
- DNREC Fish and Wildlife stipulated it would not support adding more anchor net days but will support changing the anchor net season dates.
- The Council passes a motion unanimously at the September meeting recommending that DNREC modify the spring anchor gill net season by adding two weeks in February and eliminating two weeks in April and May to better synchronize the spring anchor gill net season with the availability of and market for striped bass.
- Council further discusses recommendation at January 17, 2024 meeting and recommends a minor modification to the start and end dates.

7 DE Admin. Code 3505 Striped Bass Commercial Fishing Seasons; Quotas; Tagging and Reporting Requirements Proposed Change In January 2024 Register

1.0 It is unlawful for any commercial food fisherman using a gill net to take and reduce to possession any striped bass at any time except when said commercial food fisherman is authorized by the Department to participate in a commercial gill net fishery for striped bass established herein. A commercial food fisherman may use a gill net to take and reduce to possession striped bass during the period beginning at 12:01 A.M. on February 15 and ending at 4:00 P.M. on May 31 next ensuing. It is unlawful to use any gill net having a stretched-mesh size greater than four (4) inches to take striped bass during the period February 15 beginning at 12:01 A.M. on April 27 and ending at 4:00 P.M. on May 31 until and including the last day in February unless the net is drifted. A commercial food fisherman may use a gill net to take and reduce to possession striped bass during the period beginning at 12:01 A.M. on November 15 and ending at 4:00 P.M. on December 31 next ensuing provided at least two (2) percent of the commercial allocation of striped bass for the gill net fishery, as determined by the Department, was not landed in the February - May gill net fishery. In order for a commercial food fisherman to be authorized by the Department to participate in a commercial gill net fishery, said commercial food fisherman shall have a valid food fishing equipment permit for a gill net and shall register in writing with the Department to participate in said fishery by February 1 for the February 15 - May 31 gill net fishery and by November 1 for the December gill net fishery.

7 DE Admin. Code 3505 Striped Bass Commercial Fishing Seasons; Quotas; Tagging and Reporting Requirements Modification Recommended by ACTF at January 17, 2024 Meeting

1.0 It is unlawful for any commercial food fisherman using a gill net to take and reduce to possession any striped bass at any time except when said commercial food fisherman is authorized by the Department to participate in a commercial gill net fishery for striped bass established herein. A commercial food fisherman may use a gill net to take and reduce to possession striped bass during the period beginning at 12:01 A.M. on February 15 and ending at 4:00 P.M. on May 31 next ensuing. It is unlawful to use any gill net having a stretched-mesh size greater than four (4) inches to take striped bass during the period [beginning at 12:01 A.M. on February 15 and ending at 4:00 PM on February 19 and beginning at 12:01 A.M. on May 2] and ending at 4:00 P.M. on May 31 until and including the last day in February unless the net is drifted. A commercial food fisherman may use a gill net to take and reduce to possession striped bass during the period beginning at 12:01 A.M. on November 15 and ending at 4:00 P.M. on December 31 next ensuing provided at least two (2) percent of the commercial allocation of striped bass for the gill net fishery, as determined by the Department, was not landed in the February - May gill net fishery. In order for a commercial food fisherman to be authorized by the Department to participate in a commercial gill net fishery, said commercial food fisherman shall have a valid food fishing equipment permit for a gill net and shall register in writing with the Department to participate in said fishery by February 1 for the February 15 - May 31 gill net fishery and by November 1 for the December gill net fishery.
