## Comments:

Hi - I'm writing in support of the application of U.S. Wind to route the off-shore Wind cable through Indian River Bay and to connect to a new substation and to the grid in Dagsboro. The Mid-Atlantic region needs Off-shore Wind to have any chance of meeting our future clean-energy needs, and to reduce air pollution and the adverse health consequences it causes. Any risk to wildlife can be lessened by appropriate planning of the work, and the risk to wildlife from climate change far outweighs the the risk from this cable, and the operation of the wind farm. I recently had the opportunity to view the Vineyard Sound wind farm in Massachusetts. From the shore the turbines are barely visible on the clearest day. It is highly unlikely a similar, but smaller project off the Delaware coast will have any negative impact on tourism, nor will the cable to land the electricity from the windfarm. Approval of the landfall in Delaware of this cable can have only positive impacts for Delaware, and will pave the way for future projects further off-shore.
