## Comments:

Hello, I am urging you on behalf of Delawareans and our environment to block the wind project. Below are points of concern. 3Rs is Delaware's most popular, and best producing fishing beach. Drilling there will cause unreversable damage, and fishing there will suffer. The landscape would be forever changed much like Hurricane Sandy did to Deemers Beach in New Castle. The striper never returned in bulk migrations as they did before the storm. The environmental damage of the dunes will be severe. As a Delawarean, we are often told by your agency how precious our dunes are, and are fined if we so much as step on the dunes. Big Green is now going to destroy those dunes by drilling.
