I'm against this project which will disturb the coastline and wetlands of Delaware for the benefit of bringing power to Maryland. Is Maryland and US Wind paying Delaware an annual fee for the use of Delaware land for the project? Lastly, is there a provision in the contracts or law which requires US Wind and/or Maryland to dismantle, remove and restore Delaware land and wetlands at the projects end of life? This is generally required in the oil and gas industry when they build platforms and pipelines on federal and state land. Also, US Wind should be required to pay into a fund annually run by Delaware to be sure funds are ultimately available to perform the dismantlement, removal and restoration. Otherwise, if US Wind goes bankrupt, where will the money come from to do the work.
