### Comments:

I am strongly opposed to granting US Wind's application to bring power lines ashore at 3Rs Beach in Delaware Seashore State Park and interconnect into a proposed substation in the Indian River. My reasons are as follows: 1. This land is dedicated public park land and has been for generations. The use proposed by applicant is totally incompatible with the park purpose of this land. The cable may likely come unmoored and the risk of accidents and other emergencies from this industrial use is not studied or known. The public purpose of this area will be subverted to profit a corporation primarily. 2. This proposed use is an industrial use and incompatible with the Coastal Zone Act which has saved Delaware Bay and Delaware ocean beaches from becoming industrialized like Galveston TX. 3. This proposed use will provide negligible benefit to Delaware. It may provide a few random jobs. The majority of the benefit is to Maryland and the electrical grid serving areas other than Delaware. Why would Delaware allow its resources to be threatened for such a negligible benefit? It makes no sense to me as a Delaware homeowner and taxpayer.
