The proposed US Wind project as planned will cause significant and irreparable harm to the environment both within the ocean, and in the bay areas where proposed dredging will occur. Additionally, the project plan places extremely tall turbines far too close to shore, and will thus cause harm to the enjoyment of our seashore, and the value of our properties will be significantly degraded. Practical changes can be made now, to both benefit from green energy production, and protect our ocean and our seashore. Require US Wind to build much farther off-shore, out of our sealife's breeding and migratory path. Ensure that their turbines are not visible from shore. Bring their cables inland within Maryland, who benefits from the power generated.
