U.S. Wind, Inc. Notice of Permit Applications, Public Information Session and Public Hearing

The Department of Natural Resources and Environmental Control (DNREC: Division of Water and Division of Watershed Stewardship) hereby provides public notice of perm applications submitted by US Wind, Inc., and of a Joint Public Information Session and a Joint Public Hearing (Docket #2024-P-MULT-0007) to be held by DNREC regardin thöse applications.

US Wind, inc., proposes to develop a commercial-scale, effectore which energy project in the Lesse Area Inson as Lesse OC=A 4040 offectore of Maryland ("proposed opticat"). The proposed notice is comprised of up to 12 wind turbine spectrations, up to four effectory induces export cable, and com meteorological toxer; in a gridded array pattern distributed across the Lesse Area, Portions of the proposed export cables are toxed and a subaqueous lanks in the Adatric Costa within Delaware state waters and the Indian River Bay. The offshore (indicated under state-regulated wellands and the DMREC building line, parting to and potential dure environments and to interconnect into a proposed substation to be constructed on tax parcel 233-2.00-2.01 adjacent to the Indian River Power Rant in Susce County, Delaware.

The proposed project will require the following permits/authorizations from DNREC for the proposed installation of cable ducts and offshore/onshor export cables using horizontal direction drilling, dredging and trenching, and for the proposed construction of a transition vault using horizontal direct tional drilling: Division of Water:

- Subsequence Lande Permit/Lase
 The propose project spacing date-regulated subsqueeces lands (starting at the 3 mile jurisdictional line) is comprised of up to four transmission cables and will terminate into a proposed substation to be constructed on tax parcel 233:200-201 adjacent to the Indian River Power Plant in Sussex County, Delaware. Additionally the applicant proposes to conduct deriging to facilitate construction of the offshore wind project and associated infrastructure in the Indian River. Sussex County, Delaware. - Water Quality Certification Water Quality Certification is required for the dredging associated with the United States Army Corps of Engineers permitting for the construction of the propose offshore wind project and associated inflastructure. The applicant requests a Section \$401. Water Quality Certification. Approval is being requested to conduct dredgin within the Indian River, Sussec Comry, DE.
- Wetlande Permit
 The applicant proposes to temporarily place a pipeline associated with the proposed dredging activities across state-regulated tidal wetlands, to transport dred
 material to an usland confined disposal facility adjacent to the Indian River, Sussex County, DE.
