As a resident living on Yorklyn Road, roughly one quarter mile distant of the Quarry Walk property, I strongly object to the issuance of a permit for underground wastewater storage tanks. From the commencement of site work on the property, I've noted the waters of the stream running through my property, and neighboring pond were clouded with white kaolin clay silt, so there's no question that if there were any tank leak, or spill, that sewage and waste water would find it's way on to my property, and drinking water. Additionally, truck traffic, noise, and road damage will increase due to the frequency with which this proposed tanks will need to be pumped. I respectfully ask you to decline this application for permit, and put quality of life, health of Hockessin and Yorklyn residents above the poor planning on the part of a developer.
