**Subject:** Quarry Walk permit for temporary sewage tanks

My name is Nancy Elliott. I have lived in Yorklyn Ridge in Hockessin for 51 years. I am requesting that DNREC deny the application filed by Apex Engineering to (temporarily) place 12-1500 gallon septic tanks to service 25 townhomes yet to be built at Quarry Walk. These tanks will have to be pumped out every other day by septic trucks in order to carry waste water from these homes. My concerns are the environmental risks for contamination of the aquifer if any of these tanks leak or there is a spill while trucks are pumping out the tanks. (Artesian water provides water from this aquifer to many homes and businesses in NCCounty. ) The need for Diesel ( air pollution) sewage removal tanker trucks coming up and down Yorklyn Road every other day to empty out the septic storage tanks seems to be a premature solution intended just for the benefit of Apex Engineering and Quarry Walk, LLC so they can start to build 25 of the intended 61 homes. Since the County has not yet even begun the work or processed the plans for building a permanent sewage pumping station and sanitary sewer force main system needed that Quarry Walk has applied for and must have in place before building can begin, I am asking DNREC to DENY this application request for “temporary” sewage solution for waste water disposal by Apex Engineering and Quarry Walk LLC.

I would also hope that the density of this project will decrease the number of homes allowed to be built, that many trees would be planted to help restore some of the natural beauty that was so brutally destroyed.
