Comments:

This development has been ongoing for a year or more. It does not seem to make economic or environmental sense to use a temporary holding system that is not as secure as the permanent solution. The temporary system could leak untreated sewage into surrounding natural areas causing a disruption to the ecosystem that supports a wide range of flora and fauna. Also, pump outs every two days will result in additional heavy traffic on local roads (at a time when there will also be construction traffic supporting the building of the rest of the development). This project has already had numerous issues and conflicts with local residents due to poor communication etc, and it seems that this change is unnecessary and will cause more anguish. The draft permit does not have an expiration date. As the developer is planning such an extensive operation to install and manage the tanks, they will probably be in place for a considerable length of time, and may even become permanent. I do not support the approval of the permit to install a temporary system.
