We are opposed to the North Fish USA processing/smoking plant located at 200 Centerpoint Blvd. This plant creates several concerns. The smoking process will pollute the air, and diminish air quality. Scrubbers are insufficient. The brining process entails utilizing over 400lbs of salt daily that will be sent to the sewer, 6 days a week. The smell of the fish waste will not be reduced by the scrubbers. The amount of fish processed is purported to be between 5.5 - 11tons per day, 6 days a week. The fact that removal is needed twice a day denotes how much waste is being created. This is not a business that should be located directly next to highly populated neighborhoods. Nor should neighbors have to bear the burden of the interference with the quiet enjoyment of their properties, the air quality from the odor and the smoke, and the burden on the water supply and sewer system.
