



We invite the public to participate in a virtual public hearing scheduled for Aug. 27, 2025, at 6 p.m.

At the hearing, the Division will discuss proposed revisions to Delaware's wildlife regulations (7 DE Admin. Code 3900). Following the hearing, the public comment period will remain open through Sept. 12, 2025.

Proposed changes include:

- Expanding the age range for youth participation in special hunt days for waterfowl, turkeys and deer
- Updating language related to hunting gamebirds on Sundays
- Removing outdated text regarding harvest reporting
- Allowing motorized carts on lands administered by the Division of Fish and Wildlife
- Correcting typographical errors related to method of take and permit issuance for releasing gamebirds
- Extending the coyote hunting season to improve species management and increase hunting opportunities
