1 P R O C E E D I N G S

2 THE HEARING OFFICER: Good evening. I
3 believe everyone is connected. The time is now 6 p.m.
4 on March 25, 2026. Being that we don't have anyone
5 attending tonight's hearing from the public, I'm not
6 going to go into the closed captioning remarks. We'll
7 just skip to the information to begin the hearing.

8 The hearing is being provided this
9 evening as a virtual platform for the State of
10 Delaware's Department of Natural Resources and
11 Environmental Control to conduct its virtual public
12 hearing on Docket Number 2025-R-F-0025, the proposed
13 revisions to 7 DE Admin. Code 3560, "Total Length."
14 It is now 6:01 p.m. on March 25, 2026.

15 This hearing is being conducted
16 virtually. No one is together in the same room.
17 Everyone is participating independently at their own
18 respective locations. While we are not physically
19 gathered tonight, Zoom does generate a list of those
20 that are virtually present for the proceedings, so the
21 department will have a record of those who have
22 electronically joined this evening.

23 At the conclusion of the introductory
24 remarks, I'll be turning the hearing record over to

1 Department Staff to provide their presentation for the
2 record being generated in this matter. Where at the
3 conclusion of the presentation, we would then turn
4 their attention to the public comment portion of the
5 hearing, the Department did not receive any
6 registrations by 12 p.m. today. Therefore, those who
7 have joined tonight must submit their comments in
8 writing to the Department, which will be discussed
9 further in my remarks.

10 There is a court reporter virtually
11 present, who will prepare a verbatim transcript of
12 this hearing pursuant to the statutory requirement for
13 DNREC to have the same prepared, and, as always, that
14 transcript will be posted on the hearing webpage
15 dedicated to this matter as soon as it is received.
16 In addition, I would encourage those who are attending
17 this hearing to also visit the hearing's webpage
18 dedicated to this matter for additional details
19 concerning the proposed regulation. The hearing
20 webpage can be found online under the Administrative
21 Law Section of DNREC's website that will be listed at
22 the conclusion of tonight's hearing.

23 Before we begin the presentation,
24 please be advised of the following protocols that

1 remain in place for all DNREC public hearings. All
2 comment must be limited solely to the subject matter
3 of tonight's hearing. All comments pertinent to this
4 subject matter of this virtual hearing will be
5 incorporated into the record being generated in this
6 matter. In order to ensure that everyone who wishes
7 to offer comment for the Secretary's consideration is
8 accommodated, the record in this matter shall remain
9 open for 15 days following tonight's proceeding.

10 There is only one authentic record of
11 this formal proceeding tonight and it is the official
12 court reporter's verbatim transcript. The statutory
13 report of the statutory purpose of tonight's hearing
14 is to build the record with regard to the Department's
15 proposed actions. A record consisting of the
16 transcript of the hearing tonight, all written
17 comments, all exhibits, and eventually the Hearing
18 Officer's report will be reviewed by Secretary
19 Patterson.

20 The Secretary will ultimately issue an
21 order following that review process containing his
22 decision on this matter and the reasons therefore.
23 Per DNREC's standard hearing protocols, there will be
24 no Q&A or chat session permitted during the hearing.

1 It is important to note that no decision has already
2 been made by the Department, nor any decision will be
3 made tonight with regard to the proposed regulatory
4 matter. As previously stated, DNREC wishes to ensure
5 that everyone is unable to offer their comments for
6 inclusion to the record being generated in this
7 matter.

8 In light of the Administrative
9 Procedures Act, the Department is required to, at a
10 minimum, provide a comment period of a minimum of 15
11 days after the hearing. As noticed in the legal ads
12 and online, the Department stated that the public
13 comment period will be open through April 9, 2026.
14 Comments may be submitted through a comment form link
15 on the hearing webpage, via email to
16 dnrechearingcomments@delaware.gov, or via the US
17 Postal Services at the physical address for DNREC
18 indicated on the hearing webpage and the public
19 notices previously issued in this matter.

20 Written comments to DNREC may not be
21 submitted using social media platforms such as
22 Twitter, Facebook, YouTube, or text messaging. Please
23 remember all comment received either through USPS or
24 via the electronic mechanisms entered just now, as

1 long as is received by the Department by April 9th,
2 will bear the exact same weight and will be considered
3 equally by the Secretary prior to making a final
4 decision in this matter.

5 Lastly, the ultimate decision regarding
6 this matter is made by DNREC Secretary Patterson.
7 This formal hearing tonight acts as the mechanism to
8 enable the Department to thoroughly vet the regulatory
9 matter to the public and to let the public know the
10 various ways in which comment may be submitted for
11 Secretary Patterson's consideration if so desired. I
12 will now hand it over to John Clark with the Division
13 Of Fish And Wildlife to provide the Department's
14 presentation.

15 MR. CLARK: Thank you, Theresa. I also
16 just would like to mention that we submitted ten
17 exhibits about our outreach for this hearing, and
18 those are all available on the hearing website. And
19 now to go to the presentation. Full background on
20 proposed Regulation 3560, "Total Length." The
21 definition of total length was developed for the ASMFC
22 Addendum 3 to Amendment 7 to the Atlantic Striped Bass
23 Fisheries Management Plan, which was approved by ASMFC
24 in October 2025 and is now a mandatory compliance

1 measure for all states in the Striped Bass Management
2 Unit, which includes Delaware.

3 Because Delaware currently uses total
4 length specify the minimum and/or maximum length for
5 ten fish species by regulation and two by code, but
6 total length is not defined for any of those species,
7 we have decided to create a standalone definition of
8 total length that will apply across our regulations
9 rather than just to striped bass. A clear definition
10 of total length will improve enforceability of minimum
11 and/or maximum total length for those species, because
12 it eliminates the sometimes confusion caused when our
13 natural resources police stop an angler, they measure
14 the fish and find it is not legal, but the angler, for
15 example, will say, "Well I measured it this way," and
16 they weren't measuring total length the correct way.
17 So that is the purpose of this regulation.

18 So the proposed regulation is simple.
19 It's a standalone for total length, and it simply
20 states "Unless otherwise defined in 3500 Tidal
21 Finfish, Total Length (TL) measure is the greatest
22 straight-line length in inches as measured on a fish
23 from the anterior-most tip of the jaw or snout to the
24 farthest extremity of the tail with the upper and

1 lower fork of the tail squeezed together." And that
2 concludes the presentation.

3 THE HEARING OFFICER: Thank you, Mr.
4 Clark. As you previously stated, the electronic
5 versions of the exhibits were submitted by the
6 Department, and those exhibits are posted on the
7 hearing webpage as a Exhibit 1, Start Action Notice;
8 Exhibit 2, the Regulatory Flexibility Analysis;
9 Exhibit 3, the Register Notice SAN Number 2025-15, and
10 the proposed regulations to 70 DE Admin. Code 3560,
11 "Total Length"; Exhibit Number 4, the Notice of Public
12 Hearing as it appeared on the Delaware State Public
13 Meeting Calendar; Exhibit Number 5, the Notice on the
14 Public Hearing as it appears on DNREC's Public Hearing
15 Website Page; Exhibit 6, the Proof of Publication and
16 Legal Notice on the Wilmington News Journal; Exhibit
17 7, the Publication of the Legal Notice as Published in
18 the Delaware State News; Exhibit 8, a Copy of the
19 Hearing Presentation as Provided Online Today; and
20 Exhibit 9, the Email Notice Regarding the Hearing on
21 the Proposed Regulation Sent on March 18th and March
22 25th to All People Enrolled in Division of Wildlife
23 Fisheries Email Notification; and Exhibit 10, Notice
24 of the Public Hearing for Proposed Regulations 70 DE

1 Admin. Code 3560, "Total Length," as it Appeared on
2 DNREC's Fish and Wildlife Facebook page. And I hereby
3 mark those Exhibits 1 through 10 as the Department's
4 Exhibits 1 through 10.

5 (Exhibit 1 through Exhibit 10 were
6 marked for identification.)

7 THE HEARING OFFICER: Now that the
8 Division's presentation has concluded and we do not
