Comments:

1) Magnet fishing should be allowed without restrictions. If anything, individuals are helping to clear water ways and reduce metal/chemical pollution. 2) Parks should be allowed to stay open 24/7 with the following safety precautions: adequate lighting in the playground, parking, and pavillion/picnic areas, 24/7 park patrol/police presence, and accessible emergency telephones or sirens of some kind. 3) Marijuana, vaping and alcohol should be permitted if being used by legal adults in specified areas, such as on campsites being paid for/rented, on personal kayaks/canoes, or in pavilions that are being paid for/rented. 4) Individuals should not be able to re-sell their camping reservations for profit. If someone cannot attend a reservation, they should be able to: gift it to a friend or relative, exchange their reservation for a new date/time, or request a refund while allowing the park to re-open/repost the refunded date/time. 5) No comment on surf fishing. 6) People using the playground or family friendly waterpark areas should have attire on that is also family friendly. On hiking trails, on campsites, on the water, etc., people should be able to wear whatever they would like.
