Applaud the Parks division for suggesting a speed limit for e-bikes. I walk the CHSP Bike Loop every day. In addition to a speed limit, I suggest the following actions (which were also suggested in a letter today to Director Ritter: 1. Every person registering at the campground or borrowing a bike from the Bike Barn should be given a card with a few safety rules. It should be brief and could say as little as Keep right, move left to pass; give warning when overtaking. 2. Suggest bikes travel single file and pedestrian walk no more than 2 abreast. 3. Change the signage from "Bike Loop" to "Bike/Ped Loop" -- bikers are shouting to walkers to get off since this is a bike path. 4. Paint a center strip on path to reinforce separation 5. Enforcement. Admittedly difficult but far better if police officer is on a bike.
