

**Subject:** Comments on Proposed State Park Regulation Changes

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**To:** HearingComments, DNREC (MailBox Resources)

Section 10.6.1.2 covers reduced speed limits in parking, camping, and congested areas for motorized vehicles. Adding signage in congested areas on trails, such as on the raised areas on the Gordon Pond trail, that apply to all vehicles should be considered.

Section 12.1.2 Consider changing to "Bicycles must be ridden as far right as is reasonably safe to do so on roadways and trails.

Section 12.1.5.2 Adding reflectors for side visibility of 600 feet on sides seems excessive and not practical.

Section 12.1.9 "Speed on trails shall not exceed 15 miles per hour." This needs to be modified so that, in the narrow, congested parts of the Gordon Pond Trail, such as on the raised path, speeds need to be reduced depending on the number of pedestrians and bikers.

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
