It is my understanding there will be a review of the current regulations regarding solid waste. Unfortunately, I will be out of town and not will not be able to make a comment on January 6. I request that you please alter your fees for small groups/companies who want to compost. The current situation makes it untenable for these smaller organizations to participate. As it stands now, the fees are counter productive to what DNREC's goals are. Please give an exemption (from DNREC's industrial Composting permit process)to community Composting and small scale Composting. I also urge you to provide a hauling permit exemption from moving small amount of food scraps I currently compost and have talked to various people about this. Many people would like to compost, but have no place to put their materials after they have collected it. New Jersey, Maryland and some municipalities in Pennsylvania have recognized the need to promote and make it easier for community Composting. Please review their regulations to make Delaware a more sustainable state.
