On behalf of Eastern Shore Natural Gas (Applicant), Geo-Technology Associates, Inc. (GTA) is submitting this application to install permanent above-ground piping and valves that are being added to the existing 16-inch diameter pipeline system (known as the Hockessin-Polly Drummond Segment). Ground disturbance will take place to install piping and valves, construct fence and install stone within the fenced areas. To facilitate the Application's review, GTA is submitting the following information for your review and processing:

- 1. Completed Coastal Zone Management Act Federal Consistency Form;

Area of launch (Location 1A) is located on a portion of New Castle County Tax Parcel 08-02900-011 located along Paper Mill Road, and receiving location (Location 1B) located on a portion of New Castle County Tax Parcel 08-054.30-172 located on the northwest corner of Polly Drummond Hill Road and Chestnut Avenue. No direct impact to wetlands or waterbodies are proposed.





SITE LOCATION MAP HOCKESSIN-POLLY DRUMMOND SEGMENT (LOCATION 1A)







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
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SEGMENT (LOCATION 1A) NEW CASTLE COUNTY, DELAWARE


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


