# IV. General Analysis of Coastal Effects (attach additional sheets if necessary):

The project proposes installation of a pier and dock fitted with a boat lift which will bridge over inter-tidal shoreline with a narrow band of shrub and emergent wetlands. No state regulated wetlands are impacted. A vinyl sheet pile retaining wall will be installed at the existing upland edge to create a stable and secure pier head area which will prevent any bank erosion at that location. Many similar dock structures are present and have been state and federally authorized along this portion of the Lewes Rehoboth Canal. The addition of the Meoli dock will have no substantial environmental impact and will not alter the nature of the surroundings. The dock will be channelward of the federal navigation channel and its buffer.

# V. Detailed Analysis of Consistency with DCMP Enforceable Policies (attach additional sheets if necessary):

No state regulated wetlands will be impacted. The proposed retaining wall impacts 48 square feet of federally regulated wetlands and shoreline above mean high water. A Corps permit will be obtained prior to construction

The project involves construction of a single dock and pier structure landward of the federal channel and buffer similar to other residential docks as currently exist along the canal. No significant impact.

A Subaqueous Land Permit will be obtained from the DNREC Wetland & Subaqueous Lands Section (WSLS) prior to construction. The dock is designed in accordance with WSLS standards.

No state owned lands are involved. A Real Estate License will be obtained from the Baltimore District Corps of Engineers prior to any construction.
