Re: Coastal Zone Management Federal Consistency Review to Support the Indian River Flood Shoal Dredging and Beneficial Use <u>Emergency Project</u>

Dear Mr. Snyder,

Please accept this request for a Federal Consistency review under the Coastal Zone Management Act of 1972 to support the proposed Indian River Flood Shoal Dredging and Beneficial Use Emergency Project. The proposed project would involve dredging the Indian River Inlet flood shoal and using all dredged material for renourishment of the northside Indian River Inlet beach (North Beach), Delaware Seashore State Park, Sussex County, Delaware. The intention is to replicate the previous dredge design depths performed by the US Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) in 2013 during an emergency action following Hurricane Sandy.

A dune breach occurred most recently on August 17-18, 2024 at North Beach that caused severe flooding and closure of the Delaware State Route-1 (SR-1) northbound lane. Given the extreme conditions and coastal erosion, USACE granted DNREC Shoreline and Waterway Management Section (SWMS) 'Special (Emergency) Permit Processing Procedures for Application No. NAP-2024-00438-85)' on August 23, 2024. In addition, the DNREC Wetlands and Waterways Section granted DNREC SWMS an Emergency Waiver (WA-134/24) in accordance with the Subaqueous Lands Act for beach nourishment activities along North Beach on August 19, 2024.
