Dear DNREC Coastal Zone Review Representative,

I am writing to you concerning your review of the Coastal Zone Act in conjunction with the Project Washington data center. As a citizen of Delaware, I rely on you and your fellow representatives in DNREC to consider the Coastal Zone Act protections regarding coastal resources over the interests of industrial development by prohibiting certain uses, such as mega data centers, because of the environmental threats that they pose against the citizens, our quality of life, and the environment of Delaware.

The site of this project and the massive size of this project are alarming Delaware citizens. We put our trust in you to decide what is good and not good for Delaware. The quality of life for all Delaware citizens, along with pollution controls for our air, water and sound pollution, are very important considerations for all of us whether we live close to the project or not. We will all be affected in some way in Delaware. Even our electrical grid and water supplies would be challenged and probably overwhelmed by the demand of the data centers being proposed in Delaware, making utility prices skyrocket.

Since this data center would be one of the largest heaving industrial developments in the Delaware coastal corridor (nearly 29 times the size of a prohibited industrial site), I am asking DNREC to declare that they should not be permitted in the Coastal Zone and that you deny their application, based on the data center being a heavy industrial facility.
