I am writing to you today with profound concern regarding the proposed "Project Washington" data center slated for Delaware City. I must strongly articulate my opposition to this development, as it presents numerous and significant threats to our community and its invaluable natural resources.

My apprehension stems from a comprehensive understanding of the potential repercussions. Beyond the immediate and inherent risk of increased air and water pollution—factors that directly impact the health and well-being of every resident—this project carries far-reaching environmental consequences. Data centers are known for their prodigious energy consumption, which, if not sourced entirely from renewable means, will exacerbate our carbon footprint. Furthermore, their cooling systems often demand vast quantities of water, potentially straining our precious local water supplies and impacting aquatic ecosystems.

We must prioritize the long-term environmental integrity and public health of Delaware City and the whole state over any short-term industrial gains. I urge you to take decisive action to halt this proposal and protect the irreplaceable natural heritage that generations of families, including my own, depend upon for their livelihood and quality of life.
