I am writing to you as a lifelong Delawarean in regard to Project Washington and how this project breaks the Coastal Zone act of 1971. The last time I checked DATA CENTERS are not manufacturing anything, and this has no legal pathway to be built. This act permits the manufacturing of something new - which means transforming physical material into new products. Since this is not manufacturing and not a grandfather site, the Coastal Zone Act does prohibit it. The diesel generators will destroy our air quality. The data center will drain more power than every Delaware home combined. The Coastal Zone Act is to protect our coast for recreation and tourism which we are founded on.
