Accident includes continuous or repeated exposure to conditions or which results in bodily injury, property damage, or environmental damage which the insured neither expected nor intended.

SPILL CONTROL PLAN FOR SOLID WASTE HAULERS

- 1. Spill control and safety equipment carried in each vehicle:
 - a. Reflective triangle and/or flares
 - b. Fire extinguisher
 - c. First aid kit
 - d. Heavy-duty gloves, hard hat
 - e. Flashlight
 - f. Absorbent pads and powder spill absorbent
 - g. Shovel and bucket
- 2. All loads will be enclosed, covered, or tarped to prevent accidental discharge of water during transport to the disposal facility.
- 3. The driver will perform the following pre-trip inspections:
 - a. Walk around truck visually checking for any wet spots on the group
 - b. Visually inspecting to ensure all valves are closed
 - c. Visually inspecting to ensure all hatches are closed
- If there is an accident or other emergency which causes a portion of the load to be spilled, the driver, if uninjured, will contact the following designated company coordinator:
 - a. John Dixon, 814-330-4351
- 5. The designated coordinator will contact the state and municipal authorities where the accident occurred. If the accident or spill has the potential to cause environmental damage, (either due to the nature of the water, location of the accident, or additional factors such as leaking oil, gasoline, or hydraulic fluid) the person contacted will notify the state emergency response team, by calling one of the following numbers:
 - a. Delaware: 911, 302-739-9401 or 1-800-662-8802
 - b. Pennsylvania: 911, 1-800-541-2050
- 6. This plan will be carried in all vehicles, along with the permit .

Driver Training

Driver Training and Safety

All employees authorized to operate company owned or leased vehicles will participate in initial and semi-annual to annual driver safety training, that will be implemented in our monthly company safety meetings that will include:

Defensive Driving
Vehicle Inspection
Accident Procedures
Hazardous Weather Driving
Procedure for notification of unsafe vehicles
Backing Procedures
Loading and Unloading

Only authorized employees will drive a commercial motor vehicle.

All drivers will have a current, valid commercial driver's license with tanker endorsement, at all times.

Quarterly review of employee driver's records is conducted by PDQuality Transport's insurance provider, to check for any moving violations not associated with the current employment. Any driver found to have excessive moving violations not reported to PDQuality Transport will be suspended, and/or terminated.

Authorized drivers are not allowed to operate the vehicle while under the influence of alcohol, illegal drugs, or unauthorized prescription drugs. Refer to Drug, Alcohol, and Weapons (Substance Abuse Program).

All vehicle incidents and traffic violations are to be reported to the Director of Operations immediately. Refer to Accident/Incident Reporting and Investigation.

Vehicles shall be maintained in safe working order. Refer to General Safety Rules.

All vehicles are verified to be the correct size and designed for intended use. PDQuality Transport, LLC drivers/employees shall ensure that all loads are secure and within the manufacturer's legal limits.

All persons operating vehicles for PDQuality Transport, LLC in any capacity will wear seat belts.

Safe behaviors are to be maintained at all times while driving vehicles, including hands-free cell phone use, prohibited cell phone use while driving, not manipulating radios or other equipment which may cause distraction, and not exceeding the posted speed limit and maintaining a safe distance between other vehicles.

Driving:

Do not drive if drowsy

Plan ahead; anticipate hazards - drive slower in hazardous conditions or hazardous areas

Don't trust the other driver to drive properly.

Don't speed or tailgate

Pass only in safe areas and when excessive speed is not required

Do not stop for hitchhikers or to provide roadside assistance
