MASTER EQUIPMENT LEASE

THIS MASTER EQUIPMENT LEASE (this "Lease") is made and entered into as of August 15, 2021 (the "Commencement Date"), by and between Sustainable Trailer, LLC ("LESSOR") and Voyager Trucking Corp. ("LESSEE").

In consideration of their mutual promises and other valuable consideration, and intending to be legally bound, LESSEE and LESSOR agree as follows:

1. **LEASE OF EQUIPMENT**. LESSOR hereby leases to LESSEE and LESSEE hereby leases from LESSOR the equipment described in attached Schedule 1 (the "Equipment"), as amended from time to time, which shall serve as receipt of the Equipment. During the term of the Lease, LESSEE shall have exclusive possession, control, and use of such Equipment.

2. **TERM**. The term of this Lease shall be for 12 months (1 year), commencing on the Commencement Date of this Lease, and shall automatically renew each year unless terminated as otherwise provided herein.

a. **Right to terminate**: Either party may terminate this Lease with thirty (30) days prior written notice to the other party, or may elect to remove or add Equipment on Schedule 1 with thirty (30) days prior written notice to the other party.

b. **Return**: Upon termination of the Lease or election to remove Equipment, LESSEE shall return the Equipment to LESSOR at the location designated by LESSOR, and present to LESSOR an Equipment Receipt in the form attached as Addendum A evidencing the return of the Equipment. Upon notification of a modification to the Equipment subject to this Lease, the parties shall amend Schedule 1 to reflect the Lease Payment due for the new or removed Equipment; however, all other terms and conditions of this Lease shall remain in effect as to Equipment identified on the amended Schedule 1.

3. **LEASE PAYMENTS**.

a. **Lease Payment**. LESSEE shall pay LESSOR for the use of the Equipment, lease payments in the amounts set forth in Schedule 1, per month, per vehicle (each, plus all taxes and any other charges due thereon or associated therewith, a "Lease Payment") for a total of 12 payments, together with all additional charges as may be provided herein.

b. **Additional Charges**. LESSEE shall pay, in addition to the Lease Payment specified in Schedule 1, all additional charges due at any time hereunder (each, an "Additional Charge") including without limitation all taxes (as provided in Section 14), fees, base plate and license fees, maintenance costs, fuel, empty mileage, permits of all types, tolls, ferries, detention and accessorial services, and charges for structural alteration, special equipment, painting, lettering or artwork required to maintain its state or federal Operating Authority. LESSEE shall bear the full cost of any modification or additional equipment required to bring the Equipment into compliance with applicable statutes and/or regulations, including without limitation any coming into force after execution of this Lease.

c. **Offset**. LESSEE hereby waives any and all existing and future claims, defenses, and offsets against any Lease Payment or other payments due to LESSOR hereunder. LESSEE agrees to pay each Lease Payment and other amount when due hereunder, regardless of any claim, defense, or offset that may be asserted on its behalf.

d. LESSOR is not required to purchase or rent any products, equipment, or services from the LESSEE as a condition of entering into this Lease.

4. **USE AND COMPLIANCE WITH APPLICABLE LAWS**. LESSEE shall use the Equipment in a careful and proper manner, and shall assume complete responsibility for the operation of the Equipment for the duration of the Lease, including loading and unloading the property onto and from the Equipment. LESSEE shall not use the Equipment in violation of any foreign, federal, state, territorial, or municipal law or regulation and shall be solely responsible for any fines, penalties, or forfeitures occasioned by any violation thereof while using the Equipment. LESSEE shall not operate the Equipment in any manner that would contravene the uses and purposes stipulated in the insurance policies referred to herein or in Section 11. Nothing herein shall authorize LESSEE or any other person to operate the Equipment, or to incur any liability or obligation on behalf of LESSOR.

5. **MAINTENANCE**. LESSEE agrees to maintain the Equipment in accordance with the regulations of the U.S. Department of Transportation. LESSEE shall pay the cost of all maintenance and repairs as are necessary for the safe

and efficient operation of the Equipment, including maintenance, inspections, or repairs sufficient to comply with all applicable statutes and government rules and regulations now or hereafter in effect.

6. **ALTERATION.** Without the prior approval of LESSOR, LESSEE shall not make any alterations, additions, improvements or other modifications to Equipment during the term of this Lease.

7. **CONDITION OF THE EQUIPMENT.** Acceptance of the Equipment by LESSEE at the time of delivery shall constitute LESSEE'S acknowledgment that the Equipment is fit for use and is in good, safe, serviceable, and worthy condition.

8. **INSPECTION.** LESSOR shall have the right to inspect the Equipment upon request and at least once every sixty (60) days at LESSEE'S place of business, or another location specified by LESSOR. If upon inspection at any time LESSOR finds the Equipment in a condition that LESSOR in its sole discretion reasonably believes to be in breach of this Lease, such shall be an Event of Default.

9. **REPRESENTATION AND WARRANTIES.**

- a. **Representations and Warranties of Authority.** Each party represents and warrants to the other that:
- i. it has full power and authority to execute, deliver and perform its obligations under this Lease;
 - ii. the execution, delivery and performance of this Lease have been duly and validly authorized by all necessary action by such party; and
 - iii. the execution and delivery of this Lease by such party and the performance of the terms, covenants and conditions contained herein will not violate the articles of incorporation or by-laws of such party, or any order of a court or arbitrator, and will not conflict with and will not constitute a material breach of, or default under, the provisions of any material contract by which either party is bound.

These warranties shall survive the expiration or termination of this Lease.

- b. LESSOR MAKES NO WARRANTY OR REPRESENTATION, EITHER EXPRESS OR IMPLIED, AS TO ANY MATTER WHATSOEVER, INCLUDING, WITHOUT LIMITATION, THE VALUE, DESIGN, CONDITION, MERCHANTABILITY, FITNESS FOR PARTICULAR PURPOSE OR FITNESS FOR USE OF THE EQUIPMENT. LESSEE SHALL LEASE THE EQUIPMENT "AS IS, WHERE IS, WITH ALL FAULTS" under this Lease. LESSEE agrees that it has selected the Equipment upon its own judgment and expressly disclaims any reliance upon any statements or representations made by LESSOR or any persons on LESSOR'S behalf. LESSOR hereby assigns to LESSEE for and during the Lease term all manufacturer's warranties or guarantees, expressed or implied, issues on or applicable to the Equipment and LESSOR authorizes LESSEE to obtain the customary services furnished in connection with such warranties or guarantees at LESSEE'S expense. LESSOR SHALL NOT BE LIABLE FOR ANY SPECIAL, INDIRECT, INCIDENTAL OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES OF ANY TYPE OR CHARACTER RESULTING FROM THE USE, MISUSE, OPERATION OR MAINTENANCE OF THE EQUIPMENT BY LESSEE.

10. **RISK OF LOSS.** LESSEE hereby assumes and shall bear the entire risk of loss, theft, destruction, and damage to the Equipment while in its actual or constructive possession, from any cause whatsoever. Occurrence of any such loss or damage shall not relieve LESSEE of any obligation imposed under this Lease.

11. **INSURANCE.**

- a. **Insurance Policies Purchased by LESSEE.** LESSEE shall secure and maintain in effect throughout the term hereof insurance covering, and shall provide on or before the Commencement Date a Certificate of Insurance evidencing the same:
- i. Automobile Liability Coverage of \$1,000,000 per occurrence with no annual aggregate;
 - ii. Physical Damage Coverage ensuring the Equipment and trailers and chassis owned by LESSOR against all risk of loss or damage from every cause whatsoever for not less than the full replacement value thereof as determined by LESSOR. In lieu of any requirements to carry physical damage insurance, LESSEE shall place an initial security deposit with LESSOR in the amount determined by LESSOR. LESSEE understands and agrees that this security deposit will be used by LESSOR to repair any damages to any of LESSOR'S equipment that is not covered by any other policy of insurance, to pay out any advances that become due in the event of a loss, or to otherwise compensate the LESSOR for damages or loss.

- iii. Occupational accident (\$500,000) or Workers' Compensation for all employees of owner-operators/fleet drivers (in limits set forth by applicable statute), naming LESSOR as an additional insured.
- b. **Duty of LESSEE to Cooperate.** In the event of loss or damage to the Equipment, LESSEE shall immediately report such loss or damage to LESSOR, to the insurance companies underwriting such risk, and to any and all applicable governmental agencies, both federal and state, and shall furnish such information and execute such documents as may be required and necessary to collect the proceeds from the insurance policies.
- c. **Use of Proceeds of Insurance.** In the event of and only to the extent that, there is loss or damage to the Equipment which is covered by the insurance required hereunder, the proceeds of such insurance shall be applied, at LESSOR'S sole option (a) to the replacement, restoration, or repair of the Equipment, or (b) toward the payment of the LESSEE'S obligations hereunder. In the event that LESSOR elects to apply insurance proceeds to the repair or to the replacement of the damaged Equipment, this Lease shall continue in full force and effect without abatement of lease. In the event LESSOR elects to apply insurance proceeds to the payment of LESSEE'S obligations to pay lease hereunder, the LESSEE'S obligation for all or part of the lease shall cease only with respect to that part of the Equipment or that piece of Equipment lost or damaged, the amounts of lease so abated in no event to exceed the amount of insurance settlement received by LESSOR and to be apportioned equally as reductions in the amounts remaining payable for the balance of the term hereunder.
- d. LESSEE hereby irrevocably assigns to and appoints LESSOR as LESSEE'S attorney-in-fact to make claim for and reserve payment of and execute, all documents or checks received in payment of loss or damage under any insurance, and all proceeds thereof.

12. LESSEE'S FAILURE TO MAINTAIN INSURANCE.

- a. If LESSEE fails to maintain physical damage insurance or maintain sufficient funds as a security deposit for the repair and replacement of Equipment leased herein, then LESSOR may, at LESSOR'S sole option, purchase such a policy or purchase single interest insurance protecting LESSOR alone against loss and charge such insurance to LESSEE, and treat such failure as a breach of this Lease.
- b. In the event LESSEE fails to (i) secure and maintain in force at all times during the term of this Lease adequate liability insurance coverage terminable or modifiable on not less than thirty (30) days advance written notice to LESSEE and LESSOR, and/or (ii) provide LESSOR a Certificate of Insurance evidencing current coverage under such liability insurance as provided in 11(a) LESSEE shall be in default under this Lease, and LESSOR shall have remedies as provided in Section 18 of this Lease.

13. LESSEE'S INDEMNITY. LESSEE agrees as part of the consideration for this Lease, to indemnify, defend and save harmless LESSOR and its parent company, affiliates, successors and assigns from and against any and all loss, damage, claims, demands and liability of every nature (including without limitation bodily injury or death), including reasonable attorney's fees, arising directly or indirectly from or in connection with LESSEE'S possession, use or operation of the Equipment, including actions or claims for negligence or strict liability in tort but excluding losses, damages, claims, demands, or liabilities arising out of LESSOR'S sole gross negligence.

14. TAXES. LESSEE shall keep the Equipment free and clear of all levies, liens, and encumbrances and shall pay any and all taxes, license fees, registration fees, and similar charges on or relating to the Equipment, including without limitation, any and all International Fuel Tax Agreement, International Registration Plan, and Federal Highway Use taxes, sales taxes, excise taxes, personal property taxes, assessments and other governmental fees and charges on or relating to the Equipment, including all such taxes, assessments, fees, and charges upon LESSOR by reason of the ownership of the Equipment, and all such taxes, assessments, fees, and charges on the use, rental, transportation, delivery, or operation of the Equipment excepting, however, federal, state, and local net income taxes.

15. TITLE TO THE EQUIPMENT. LESSOR shall at all times retain full legal title to the Equipment, and it is understood that the LESSEE shall acquire no right, title, or interest to the Equipment, except as expressly set forth in this Lease.

16. ASSIGNMENTS AND SUBLETTING. LESSEE shall not assign, mortgage, encumber, or transfer this Lease in whole or in part, nor grant a license or concession in connection therewith, without the prior written consent of LESSOR.

17. **EVENT OF DEFAULT.** Any of the following shall be deemed an "Event of Default".
- a. Failure of LESSEE to pay any Lease Payment within ten (10) days of the date upon which the same becomes due;
 - b. If any insurance required herein is threatened to be or is terminated, cancelled, suspended, or revoked for any reason;
 - c. Any breach or failure of LESSEE to observe or perform any of its other obligations under this Lease, which shall continue for fifteen (15) days after notice in writing to LESSEE of the existence of such default;
 - d. Abandonment of the Equipment;
 - e. Dissolution, liquidation, or termination of the business of LESSEE; insolvency or failure of LESSEE to pay its debts as they mature in the ordinary course of business; the making of an assignment for the benefit of the creditors of LESSEE; the filing of a voluntary petition in bankruptcy by LESSEE; the filing of a petition or answer by LESSEE seeking a reorganization, arrangement, composition, readjustment, liquidation, or other relief of the same or different kind under any provisions of the federal bankruptcy laws or any other provisions of the federal bankruptcy laws or any other applicable insolvency law or statute; the adjudication of LESSEE as a bankrupt or insolvent; the appointment of a trustee, receiver, guardian, conservator or liquidator of LESSEE with respect to all or substantially all of its property; and the failure of LESSEE in good faith to commence promptly and pursue diligently action to dismiss such petition;
 - f. The taking of the Equipment, or any part thereof, upon foreclosure, levy, execution, attachment or other process of law or equity enforced against LESSEE;
 - g. If, in LESSOR's reasonable opinion, LESSEE has neglected, abused or misused the Equipment in any way;
 - h. If its federal or state Operating Authority is revoked, suspended or rendered inactive for any reason; and/or if LESSEE is sold, or if there is a change in control of ownership.

18. **LESSOR'S REMEDIES.** Upon the occurrence of any Event of Default, LESSOR may, at its option, in addition to any other remedy or right it has hereunder or by law, immediately exercise any one or more of the following remedies:

- a. Declare the entire amount due hereunder during the entire term of this Lease immediately due and payable without notice or demand to LESSEE;
- b. Recover from LESSEE an amount equal to the unpaid balance due and to become due during the entire term of this Lease;
- c. Cause LESSEE, at LESSEE'S expense, to return the Equipment to LESSOR at a point in the United States designated by LESSOR, or LESSOR, through its employees, agents or attorneys, may enter upon the premises where the Equipment is located and take immediate possession of the same without demand or legal process and free of all rights of LESSEE, in which case LESSEE authorizes LESSOR or its employees or agents to enter upon any premises where the Equipment may be found for the purpose of repossessing such Equipment, and LESSEE specifically waives any right of action it might otherwise have arising out of such entry and repossession, and whereupon all rights of LESSEE in the Equipment shall terminate immediately. No such retaking of possession shall constitute a termination of this Lease unless LESSEE so notifies LESSOR in writing and pays all amounts due or to become due hereunder during the entire term of this Lease;
- d. Terminate this Lease and retain all prior payments of lease and retake possession of the Equipment as provided herein;
- e. Pursue any other remedy LESSOR may have at law or equity.

19. **LESSOR EXPENSES.** Except when the violation results from the acts or omissions of the LESSOR, the LESSEE shall assume the risks and costs of fines for overweight trailers when the trailers are pre-loaded, sealed, or the load is containerized, or when the trailer or lading is otherwise outside of the LESSOR's control, and for improperly permitted loads and shall reimburse the LESSOR for any fines paid by the LESSOR. LESSEE shall also pay LESSOR all costs and expenses, including attorney's fees, incurred by LESSOR in exercising any of its rights or remedies hereunder or enforcing any of the terms, covenants, or conditions hereof.

21. ENTIRE AGREEMENT. This Lease contains the entire understanding among the parties and supersedes any prior understandings and agreements among them respecting the subject matter of this Lease.

22. PARTIES' OBLIGATIONS BINDING. This Lease shall be binding on and inure to the benefit of the parties hereto and their respective heirs, executors, administrators, successors, and assigns where permitted by this Lease.

23. LESSEE'S OBLIGATIONS AFTER TERMINATION. Expiration or termination of this Lease shall not relieve LESSEE of his obligation to pay LESSOR any outstanding fees, costs or other sums due under this Lease.

24. NON-WAIVER. No waiver of any term, covenant, or condition of this Lease shall be valid unless in writing and signed by the party or person to be charged. Forbearance or indulgence by LESSOR in any regard whatsoever shall not constitute a waiver of the term, covenant, or condition to be performed by LESSEE to which the same may apply, and until complete performance by LESSEE of any term, covenant, or condition, LESSOR shall be entitled to invoke and remedy available to LESSEE under this Lease or by law or in equity despite said forbearance or indulgence.

25. EXECUTION, GOVERNING LAW, JURISDICTION AND VENUE. THIS LEASE SHALL NOT BECOME EFFECTIVE UNTIL EXECUTED BY AN AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE OF LESSOR. THE LAWS OF THE STATE OF FLORIDA SHALL GOVERN ALL QUESTIONS, DISPUTES OR CLAIMS, WHETHER BASED IN TORT, STRICT LIABILITY, CONTRACT OR EQUITY, ARISING OUT OF OR RELATING DIRECTLY OR INDIRECTLY TO THIS LEASE, THE PERFORMANCE OR BREACH HEREOF, OR TO THE INTERPRETATION, VALIDITY, ENFORCEMENT OR EFFECT OF THIS LEASE, WITHOUT REGARD TO CHOOSE OF LAW PRINCIPLES THEREOF.

If any one or more of the provisions contained in this Lease shall for any reason be held to be invalid, illegal, or unenforceable in any respect, such invalidity, illegality, and unenforceability shall not affect any other provision hereof, and this Lease shall be construed as if such invalid, illegal, or unenforceable provision had ever been contained herein.

27. DISCLAIMER OF JOINT VENTURE, PARTNERSHIP, AND AGENCY. This Lease shall not be interpreted or construed to create an association, joint venture, or partnership between the parties or to impose any partnership obligation or liability upon either party. Neither party shall have any right, power or authority to enter into any agreement or undertaking for, or act on behalf of, or to act as or be an agent of representative of, or to otherwise bind, the other party.

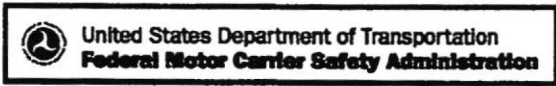
