

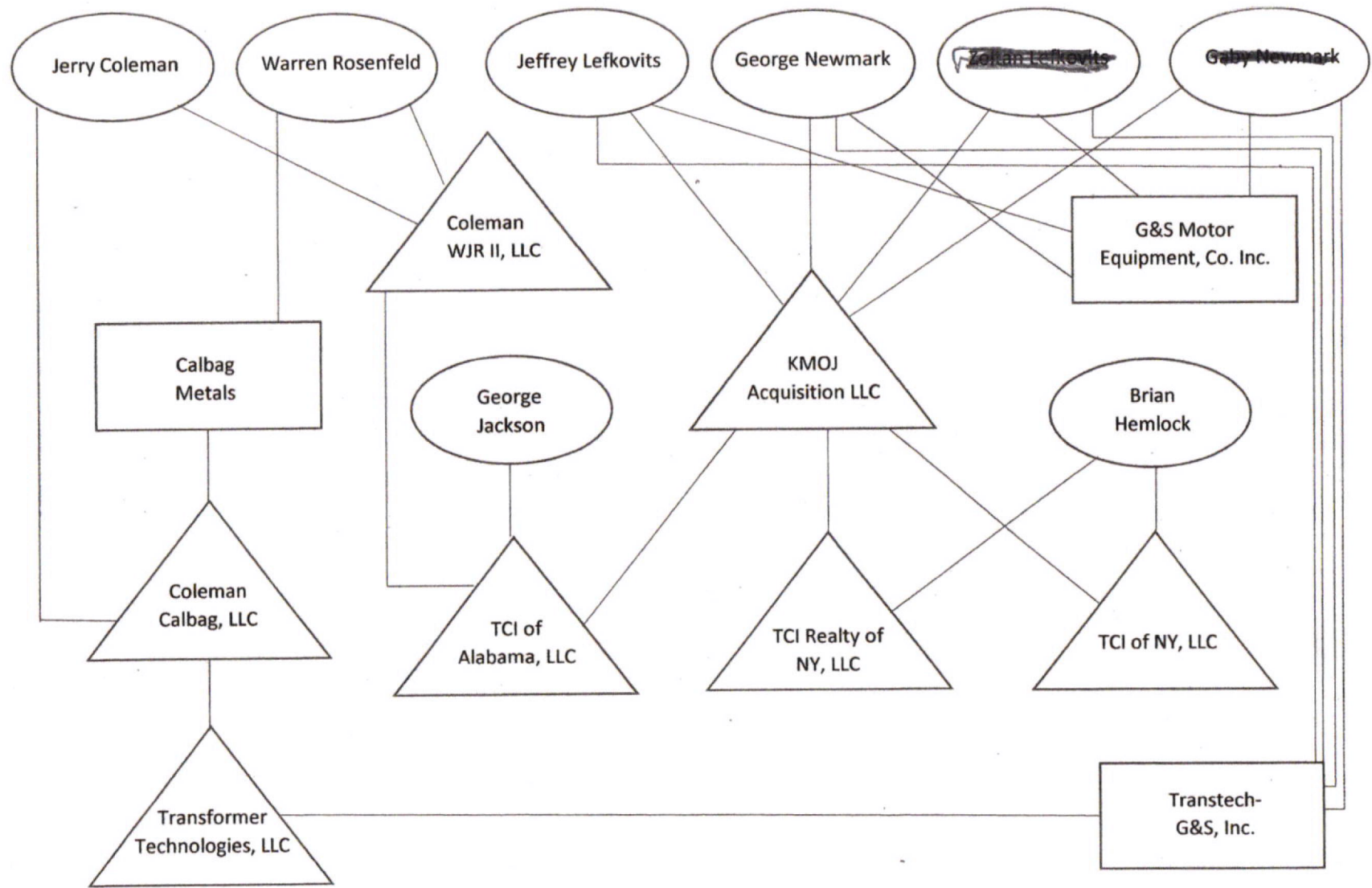

# WASTE TRANSPORTER PERMIT

## GENERAL CONDITIONS

The permittee must:

1. Carry a copy of this waste transporter permit in each vehicle to transport waste. Failure to produce a copy of the permit upon request is a violation of the permit.
2. Display the full name of the transporter on both sides of each vehicle and display the waste transporter permit number on both sides and rear of each vehicle containing waste. The displayed name and permit number must be in characters at least three inches high and of a color that contrasts sharply with the background.
3. Transport waste only in authorized vehicles. An authorized vehicle is one that is listed on this permit.
4. Submit to the Department a modification application for additions/deletions to the authorized fleet of vehicles. The permittee must wait for a modified permit before operating the vehicles identified in the modification application.
5. Submit to the Department a modification application to add a new waste category or a new destination facility, or to change the current waste or destination facility category. The permittee must wait for a modified permit before transporting new waste types or transporting to new destination facilities.
6. Submit to the Department a modification application for change of address or company name.
7. Comply with requirements for placarding and packaging as set forth in New York State Transportation Law as well as any applicable federal rules and regulations.
8. Contain all wastes in the vehicle so there is no leaking, blowing, or other discharge of waste.
9. Use vehicles to transport only materials not intended for human or animal consumption unless the vehicle is properly cleaned.
10. Comply with requirements for manifesting hazardous waste, regulated medical waste, or low-level radioactive waste as set forth in the New York State Environmental Conservation Law and the implementing regulations. Transporters who provide a pre-printed manifest to a generator/shipper/ offeror of regulated waste shall ensure that all information is correct and clearly legible on all copies of the manifest.
11. Deliver waste only to transfer, storage, treatment and disposal facilities authorized to accept such waste. Permittee must demonstrate that facilities are so authorized if requested to do so.
12. Maintain liability insurance as required by New York State Environmental Conservation Law.
13. Maintain records of the amount of each waste type transported to each destination facility on a calendar-year basis. The transporter is obligated to provide a report of this information to the Department at the time of permit renewal, or to any law enforcement officer, if requested to do so.
14. Pay regulatory fees on an annual basis. Non-payment may be cause for revocation or suspension of permit.
15. This permit is not transferrable. A change of ownership will invalidate this permit.
16. This permit does not relieve the permittee from the obligation to obtain any other approvals or permits, or from complying with any other applicable federal, state, or local requirement.



**Introduction:**

All personnel involved in working with hazardous waste endeavor to keep an emergency involving those materials from ever taking place. Adhering to strict compliance with regulations set forth by the state, federal, and provisional agencies will greatly minimize the chance of an emergency involving these materials from occurring.

Drivers/site technicians must be always prepared for the unexpected and have the following items immediately available when handling or transporting hazardous materials:

1. A current copy of this contingency plan
2. A current copy of the DOT emergency response guidebook
3. An effective means of communication (2-way radio or mobile phone)
4. A fully equipped first aid kit with eye wash
5. A flashlight
6. A respirator
7. Fire extinguisher and all other ICC-required equipment
8. Spill kit equipment listed in paragraph 9

Each day, drivers/site technicians will inspect their work site to ensure that all spill and emergency equipment is intact and readily available. Fire extinguishers also must be checked for service dates and proper pressure.

When transporting hazardous materials, drivers will also inspect this equipment prior to departure. To ensure safety of the load, drivers must follow inspection procedures as stated in TCI's Driver's Manual.

If an emergency does occur, however, there are certain actions which must be taken to protect lives and

property. It is essential that all persons who come into frequent contact with hazardous wastes be familiar with emergency measures. Prompt action on the part of all persons concerned will enable many emergencies to be controlled and minimize the possibility of injury and property damage.

In the event of a spill of hazardous waste on site, the personnel specified are to respond as described in the following procedure:

#### A. Technician's Responsibilities

1. Protect yourself. Stay upwind and uphill of any accident involving suspected hazardous materials. Do not touch any spilled material or breath, any smoke, fumes or vapors. Do not eat, drink, or smoke in the area.
2. Eliminate all sources of ignition such as flares, flames, sparks, smoking, flashers, flashlights, gas and diesel engines. Do not drive into or through any vapors or spilled materials.
3. Prevent others from entering danger areas, (2000 ft.) around accident site. Evacuate all unnecessary persons from within this area. If needed, start a down-wind evacuation.
4. Rescue injured, considering all hazards. Use all available resources (respirators, protective clothing, etc.).
5. Emergency medical treatment should be limited to first aid necessary to save a life or minimize injury. Use first aid kit as required and call for medical assistance.

For PCB Exposure:

- a. Remove contaminated clothing.
  - b. Flush skin and eyes with plenty of water for 15 minutes, do not scrub skin.
  - c. Call for medical attention.
  - d. Inform medical personnel of the nature of the hazardous material exposures.
6. Determine the hazardous materials involved using the shipping manifests, labels, placards, company personnel, etc. Obtain the correct spelling of all chemicals involved.
  7. Determine the hazards of the identified hazardous materials using available resources such as the DOT Emergency Response Guidebook, other manuals and Chemtrec 1-800-424-9300.
  8. Understand the nature of the hazardous material before applying water or any other fire-fighting agent.
  9. Notify the onsite representative for the utility.
  10. All TCI vehicles and job sites maintain a spill prevention kit on each vehicle in the event of a spill of residual oils.
    - a. The spill kits contain:



- 1) 55 Gallon DOT 17H Open-head Drum
  - 2) Shovel
  - 3) 100 lbs. of clay oil absorbent
  - 4) 60 sq. feet of oil-absorbent polypropylene blanket
  - 5) Disposable uniforms and rubber gloves
  - 6) Spill containment equipment consisting of a minimum 20-pound bundle of polypropylene absorbent pads or rolls, and disposable uniforms and rubber gloves.
  - 7) Fire extinguisher and all other ICC required equipment
  - 8) Respirator with organic vapor cartridges and P100 filters. (If needed)
11. If possible, stop leak by shutting valves, plugging holes or changing position of container.
  12. Prevent spilled material and water from fire fighting activities from running into sewers, water and buildings by diking, absorbing or diverting spill. As a general rule, spills should not be flushed. Pay particular attention to water supplies and groundwater areas. For small spills, clean up all debris and containerize in 55-gallon drums.
  13. Stabilize the accident scene and contact TCI's Emergency Coordinator as soon as possible.

  - b. Description of material spilled, including the UN or NA number
  - c. Extent of injuries and property damage
  - d. Volume of spilled material
  - e. Volume and description of other materials on vehicle
  - f. Cause of spill (leaking container, defective valve, or traffic accident)
  - g. Recommendations for emergency response (i.e., can problem be fixed, what equipment is required)


