Question 12 (a) and (b) – Driver Training

The Reybold Group of Companies requires CDL licenses for drivers who drive over 26K lbs gross vehicle weight. Class A CDL is required for combination vehicles. In addition, special endorsements are required for certain vehicles: Fuel/Lube requires HAZMAT endorsement; Water Truck requires Tank Endorsement.

Before hire, a CDL driver must successfully complete a Road Test performed by Reybold's Safety Officer. A Motor Vehicle Record check is also performed before hire. A driver must have the following: a valid driver's license, the proper license, proper endorsements and no more than eight points on their license. An "Investigation into Safety Performance History" is requested as well.

Upon hire, drivers receive a Safety and Personnel Orientation. Driver's also received Fire Extinguisher training which was conducted on May 23rd. The Company requires employees to participate in Defensive Driving and trains all employees in CPR/First Aid. In addition, weekly Tool Box Talks are conducted.

Drivers are required to complete an Annual Statement of Violations form and Motor Vehicle Record checks are performed annually on drivers and reviewed by Human Resources and/or Safety. If necessary, results are reviewed with the driver. Reybold has a progressive discipline policy and moving violations are reported on a Vehicle Violation Form. Again, if a driver has over eight points, they are not permitted to operate a Reybold vehicle.
