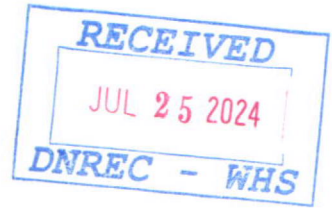

**DEFINITIONS AS USED IN THIS ENDORSEMENT**

**Accident** includes continuous or repeated exposure to conditions or which results in bodily injury, property damage, or environmental damage which the insured neither expected nor intended.

**Motor Vehicle** means a land vehicle, machine, truck, tractor, trailer, or semitrailer propelled or drawn by mechanical power and used on a highway for transporting property, or any combination thereof.

**Bodily Injury** means injury to the body, sickness, or disease to any person, including death resulting from any of these.

**Property Damage** means damage to or loss of use of tangible property.

**Environmental Restoration** means restitution for the loss, damage, or destruction of natural resources arising out of the accidental discharge, dispersal, release or escape into or upon the land, atmosphere, watercourse, or body of water, of any commodity transported by a motor carrier. This shall include the cost of removal and the cost of necessary measures taken to minimize or mitigate damage to human health, the natural environment, fish, shellfish, and wildlife.

**Public Liability** means liability for bodily injury, property damage, and environmental restoration.

The insurance policy to which this endorsement is attached provides automobile liability insurance and is amended to assure compliance by the insured, within the limits stated herein, as a motor carrier of property, with Sections 29 and 30 of the Motor Carrier Act of 1980 and the rules and regulations of the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration (FMCSA).

In consideration of the premium stated in the policy to which this endorsement is attached, the insurer (the company) agrees to pay, within the limits of liability described herein, any final judgment recovered against the insured for public liability resulting from negligence in the operation, maintenance or use of motor vehicles subject to the financial responsibility requirements of Sections 29 and 30 of the Motor Carrier Act of 1980 regardless of whether or not each motor vehicle is specifically described in the policy and whether or not such negligence occurs on any route or in any territory authorized to be served by the insured or elsewhere. Such insurance as is afforded, for public liability, does not apply to injury to or death of the insured's employees while engaged in the course of their employment, or property transported by the insured, designated as cargo. It is understood and agreed that no condition, provision, stipulation, or limitation contained in the policy, this endorsement, or any other endorsement thereon,

or violation thereof, shall relieve the company from liability or from the payment of any final judgment, within the limits of liability herein described, irrespective of the financial condition, insolvency or bankruptcy of the insured. However, all terms, conditions, and limitations in the policy to which the endorsement is attached shall remain in full force and effect as binding between the insured and the company. The insured agrees to reimburse the company for any payment made by the company on account of any accident, claim, or suit involving a breach of the terms of the policy, and for any payment that the company would not have been obligated to make under the provisions of the policy except for the agreement contained in this endorsement.

It is further understood and agreed that, upon failure of the company to pay any final judgment recovered against the insured as provided herein, the judgment creditor may maintain an action in any court of competent jurisdiction against the company to compel such payment.

The limits of the company's liability for the amounts prescribed in this endorsement apply separately to each accident and any payment under the policy because of anyone accident shall not operate to reduce the liability of the company for the payment of final judgments resulting from any other accident.

Waste Haulers have the ability to submit New, Renewal and Addendum Authorization forms for the Act 90 Waste Transportation Safety Program by accessing the Internet through [www.depgreenport.state.pa.us](http://www.depgreenport.state.pa.us). The web-based application enables haulers to start, save, submit and electronically pay for Act 90 Authorizations, as well as maintain a history of submitted information.

In order to access the web-based application, you will need to:

1. SELF-REGISTER: Log on to DEP's Greenport at [www.depgreenport.state.pa.us](http://www.depgreenport.state.pa.us) to self-register for a user name and password. A user name and password combination is unique to each individual utilizing the web-based application and is not to be shared or provided to others.
2. Once self-registered log back on to DEP's Greenport and click the Enroll button.
3. Click on the Waste Transportation Safety Program link on the DEP Greenport page to add the application to your portal information page.
4. Click on the WTSP button to begin working with the web based application.
5. Enclosed is a PIN. PIN's are associated to a specific hauler so that you can access saved and historic information. The unique hauler PIN can be provided to those associated to the hauler that will be submitting web-based authorizations using their own unique user name and password.

- (1) Spill control and safety equipment carried in each vehicle:
- 1). Reflectors and/or flares
  - 2). Fire extinguisher
  - 3). First aid kit
  - 4). Heavy-duty gloves, hard hat
  - 5). Flashlight
- (2) All loads will be enclosed, covered, or tarped to prevent accidental discharge of the waste during transport to the disposal facility.
- (3) The driver will perform the following pre-trip inspections:
- Driver Pre-Trip/ Inspection Checklist (Driver will check vehicle and fill out the driver Pre-Trip/Post-Trip Inspection Checklist, as required by the D.O.T. Federal Motor Carrier Safety Regulations)
- (4) If there is an accident or other emergency which causes a portion of the load to be spilled, the driver, if uninjured, will contact the following designated company coordinator:

- (5) The designated coordinator will contact the state and municipal authorities where the accident occurred. If the accident or spill has the potential to cause environmental damage, (either due to the nature of the waste, location of the accident, or additional factors such as leaking oil, gasoline, or hydraulic fluid) the person contacted will notify the state emergency response team, by calling one of the following numbers:

## **Driver Training**

To safely operate a commercial motor vehicle a driver must possess core knowledge and skills, often referred to as competencies.

To ensure proper training and competency from drivers.

With new or existing drivers we ensure the driver is competent by training them in a method to improve a driver's competency.

The following are the training provided to our drivers: **VLG Services Inc.**

- Typically around 8 to 16 hours of initial training before they begin transporting loads for a new company. The length and type of training is dependent on their individual knowledge and skills as well as the uniqueness of your operations. A driver orientation checklist should be created to guide the process and document each topic covered. Topics include :
- A review of your organization's general policies, procedures, and rules as well as your organization's commitment to safety and consequences for unsafe operation.
- Safety procedures, which are unique to your operations or customer requirements (e.g., load securement and protection, temperature monitoring, security measures, personal protective equipment, etc.)
- General defensive driving techniques including speed and space management, backing, lane changes, driver attention, fatigue management, etc.
- Specific skills and knowledge the driver is lacking that are identified during the hiring process
- Regulatory required training such as HAZMAT
- SPILL CONTROL, PLAN, etc.

### **Periodic – All Driver Training (Safety Meetings)**

Policies, procedures, and regulations changes throughout the year. Drivers can develop bad habits, which lead to unsafe driving or inadequate compliance with regulations. Drivers need periodic training throughout the year to ensure their knowledge and skills remain adequate. In the trucking industry periodic training is typically conducted in one-on-one- session due to the difficulty to getting all drivers together at once or in-group safety meetings. The frequency of periodic training is dependent on many factors, but two to three meetings a year is typical unless a critical issue requires immediate training,

Typical topics for periodic, all-driver training include:

- New Regulations, policies, and producers.
- Organization accidents, injuries, or other claims. Discussion of trends and corrective measures
- Organization FMCSA SMS BASIC score and violations. Discussion of trends and corrective actions needed
- A defensive driving topic.
- Regulatory required training such as HAZMAT
- SPILL CONTROL PLAN

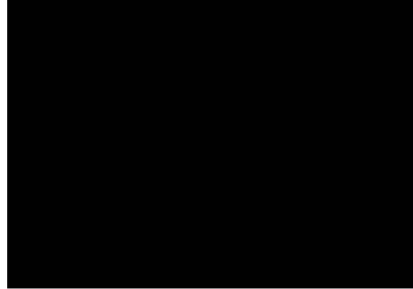
